#### **Prayer Hot Potato:**

#### What You Need:

Ball, cd player and music

#### What You Do:

Use the ball to play a game of hot potato with the children. If you have more than one ball, you can divide the children into smaller groups of nine and ten. Tell the children that each time the music stops the child holding the ball should name either a place that they can talk to God or a time that they can pray. Some examples are: morning, bedtime, mealtime, family time or play-time. Other examples are in the car, at school, at home, at church, at the dinner table, etc.

#### What You Say:

When Samuel was a young child, he went to live in the house of the Lord. He learned to serve God there. When he was older, God spoke to Samuel at night and woke him up three times. #### **Five Times to Pray**

#### What You Need:

"Five Times to Pray" activity page, coloring crayons

Help the children read the words on the fingers of the hands. Guide them as they draw lines from each finger to the corresponding picture. Ask, "As I read the words on the fingers can you find a picture that goes with each word? Ask the children to then color the pictures, discuss praying at various times of the day."
