

What You Do:


Have the children color and cut out the cake and candles. Children should glue the candles onto the cake. For older children have them glue on the right amount of candles for their age.



What You Say:



Ring Toss Happy Birthday

What You Need: Ring Toss Game

What You Do: Pretend the colored pegs are candles and have the children blow them out by tossing the rings over the colored pegs (have the children stand in a line and take turns trying to toss the rings over the pegs). When they are successful, announce the color where the ring landed and have them do the actions below that corresponds to the color of the peg.

Red: "Sing Happy Birthday to Jesus."

Yellow: "Say the memory verse."


Orange: "Tell one thing about Jesus' birthday."

What You Do:


Provide each child with a plain, colored birthday hat to decorate. Use stickers and markers to decorate the party hats.
