Everyone

What You Need: As many Fisher-Price® Little People® as you have.

What You Do:

Before the activity: Hide the Little People around the room in easy-to-find places.

During the activity: Encourage children to find all the hidden figures. Once they have, invite them to come sit down with you. Identify all the people. As you do, arrange them in a heart shape.

What You Say:

At the start of the activity: "We are on a hunt—a people hunt! I've hidden all the Little People around the room, and I need you to find them. When you've found them, come back and sit with me."

After kids have found the figures: "Great people finding! Who did you find? (Let children tell you who they found as you arrange them into a heart shape.) "We need to love everyone, the (insert the type or category of person, such as 'Mommy' or 'policeman') and the (insert the type or category of person) and the (insert the type or category of person). Jesus wants us to love everyone! Who loves you? Jesus loves you!





Baby Care

What You Need: Several dolls, play dishes, play food, Band-Aids®, a play doctor's kit, and baby blankets.

What You Do: Place the dolls, dishes, food, blankets, Band-Aids®, and the doctor kit on the floor. Explain to the children that the dolls are not feeling well and they need to be taken care of. Let the children play freely using the supplies.

What You Say: "Everyone did such a wonderful job taking care of our sick babies. You are all so good at being sweet and caring! Today we heard a Bible lesson about someone who needed love and care too. Do you remember who that was?"





Out of Place

What You Need: "Picture Page" from the Activity Pages, crayons, and markers.

What You Do:

Give each child a marker and a copy of "Picture Page." Ask them to look very closely at their pictures. Tell them that there are 10 things that do not belong in the picture. Can they find them? Instruct them to draw a circle around the pictures that do not belong and then color the rest of the picture.

What You Say:

At the start of the activity: "This is a picture about the Bible lesson we heard today. See? Here's the hurt man, and this is the man that stopped to help him. The other people who passed by the hurt man didn't stop, did they? They didn't love everyone the way **Jesus loves everyone**. **Who loves you? Jesus loves you.** That's right! We know these two men belong in this picture, but there are 10 other things that do NOT belong here. Do you think you can find the 10 things that do NOT belong in this picture and circle them? Sure you can!"

As the children work: Encourage the children one on one, asking them, "Who loves you? Jesus loves you. I can show love by helping my friends"





The Love Everyone Hop

What You Need: 3 Hula hoops, 3 red hearts, one big red heart, clear packing tape, and scissors.

What You Do:

Before the activity: Cut the hearts out of red cardstock paper. Tape the heart cutout to the floor. Place a hula hoop around each heart cutout. Place the big red heart at the end and tape it to the floor.

During the activity: Direct the children to line up in front of the hula hoops and have them jump on a heart as you say each word of the key question and then jump to the big heart as you say the Bottom Line together.

What You Say: "Stand in front of the hearts. As I say each word, you jump to the next heart, ready? Who (jump) loves (jump) you (jump)? Jesus loves you. (Jump to the big heart.) Who loves you? Jesus loves you. Great jumping! Let's do it again!
