

LG OVERVIEW The Wise Men

WORSHIP LEADER: "Hi there, friends! How are you? (Pause.) Did you have a fabulous Christmas? (Let a few of the children share.) What was your very favorite gift? (Let a few more children share.) WOW! Those are some great gifts! My very favorite gift was (gift). Hey, does anyone remember what the very best Christmas gift EVER was? (Pause.) Yes! It was Jesus! God gave us Jesus, His Son, so we could know how much He loves us! How do we know God loves us? (Pause.) Because God gave us Jesus. That's right! Let's sing about that right now! Everyone up on your feet!"

Lead children in singing "Life with Jesus" and "Great Big God"

WORSHIP LEADER: "You guys sounded great! Does anyone remember what our Memory Verse says? (*Pause.*) It sounds a lot like **God gave us Jesus,** doesn't it? (*Pause.*) It sure does. It says, 'God has given a son to us,' Isaiah 9:6. Let's say that together."

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God has given a son to us.' Isaiah 9:6."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Let's say it again as LOUD as you can! Ready?"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God has given a son to us,' Isaiah 9:6."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Let's get ready for our Bible story; things are really getting exciting with Mary, Joseph, and Baby Jesus! I think they may get some visitors today. I can't wait to find out who is coming! I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a single minute of our Bible story!
