LG OVERVIEW

I CAN HELP OTHERS!

WORSHIP LEADER: “Hello, friends! Welcome to Happy Helper month. I’m so excited to share our new Happy Helper songs with you. This month is all about people who were big helpers in the Bible and how you can be a helper too. So when I say, ‘Who can help others?’ you say, ‘I can help others.’ Let’s try it. **Who can help others?’**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “I can help others.”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Great job! You can help others. This month, we have a new song to learn but first, let’s start with one we all know! Are you ready? (Pause.) Let’s go!”

Lead children in singing “Great Big God” and “Love One Another,” this month’s worship song.

“What incredible singers you are! Thanks so much for singing about helping with me. **Who can help others?’**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “I can help others.”

WORSHIP LEADER: “That’s right! **I can help others.** The Bible tells us to be kind and loving to each other. You know what is really kind and loving? Helping! Let’s learn our Memory Verse together. Are you ready? Watch me say it and do the motions, and then you can do it with me. ‘Be kind and loving to each other’, Ephesians 4:32. Let’s try that together.”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “‘Be kind and loving to each other’, Ephesians 4:32.” (Repeat several times.)

WORSHIP LEADER: “This week our lesson is about a girl named Ruth and how she helped Naomi by staying with her when she could have returned to her hometown. Then, Boaz helped them both by making sure they had enough to eat and were cared for. We can help our families by being with them when they have troubles and making sure they have what they need. Let’s get ready for our Bible lesson, I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a single minute of our Bible story!”
