


October Weeks 1 and 2

LG OVERVIEW

THE BIBLE TELLS ME HOW MUCH GOD LOVES ME!

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yay! I'm so glad to see you today! It's so much fun to sing with you. We've got a great lesson today, but we have to do something before we do our story. Who can help me remember what we do now? (Pause.) Yes, we get to sing! I had forgotten. Oh, I forgot something else. **Who loves you?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God loves me."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes, He does! I love that we get to sing about that."

Lead children in singing "Great Big God" and "I Like To".

"Great singing, my friends. I love learning that **God loves me. Who loves you?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God loves me."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Exactly. **God loves me.** The Bible tells us that, doesn't it? Let's review our Memory Verse. 'I have loved you with a love that lasts forever', Jeremiah 31:3. (*Open your hands like a book.*) Do that with me."

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "I have loved you with a love that lasts forever", Jeremiah 31:3." (Repeat several times.)

WORSHIP LEADER: "You are all AMAZING at that verse! Have you shown your parents yet? How about your brother and sister? Make sure you show them today!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "In this week's lesson, we will hear about a women who lost a coin and how she searched and searched to find it. Our God loves you so much that He will always seek you too! Let's get ready for our Bible lesson, I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a single minute of our Bible story!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Great job listening, everyone! Are you ready to sing another song with me? (Pause.) You are? Great! Let's sing!"

Lead children in singing "Nobody Loves Me Like You" and "I Can Do All Things" (Have children sit during final song and dismiss children throughout the song or dismiss children without using the fourth song.)

WORSHIP LEADER: "Great job, friends! Now, remind me. **Who loves you?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God loves me."
