Story Time

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some kids (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's OK. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need: "Story Sequence" from the Activity Pages copied on cardstock

What You Say:

"Hey, super friends! *(Flip over the card with the picture of Daniel and the king.)* Say hello to Super Kid Daniel. Daniel loved God and prayed to Him every day. Daniel worked for the king and they were friends. This made some guys very grumpy! *(Flip over the card with the picture of the grumpy men.)* Those grumpy guys tricked the king and he said that no one could pray to anyone but him and if they did they would be thrown into a den of hungry lions! Yikes! *(Flip over the card with the picture of Daniel praying.)* But Daniel was brave and knew that God was with him, so he kept praying every day.

"But because of the law he made, the King had to throw Daniel in with the lions. *(Flip the card over with the picture of the lions' den with a sad king.)* The king worried about his friend Daniel all night long and in the morning he ran to the lions' den and called out for Daniel. And Daniel answered him and he was pulled out. *(Flip the card over with the picture of Daniel out of the lions' den with a happy king.)* Daniel told the king that God had sent an angel to shut the mouths of the lions. Daniel was safe. God had been with him the whole time and he helped Daniel be brave.

"God helped Daniel be brave. And He can help you too! **How can you be brave? God helps me be brave!**"
