LG OVERVIEW

EASTER

WORSHIP LEADER: "Hello, hello friends. It's Easter time!! It's a great day! It's time to sing! Are you ready to sing with me? Stand up if you are! Wahoo! But first, remind me. **Who can you follow?**"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "I can follow Jesus!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes!! I can follow Jesus! You got it! Let's sing!"

Lead children in singing "Shout" and "Praise the Lord Everyday"

"Yay! What incredible singers you are. **Who can you follow?**"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "I can follow Jesus!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes indeed, I can follow Jesus! Who can help me remember what we do next. We sang our songs. What do we do now? (Pause.) Yes! We say our memory verse. Are you ready to say it with me? "Come, and follow me", Jesus said', Matthew 4:19. Let's do it again."

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Come, and follow me', Jesus said", Matthew 4:19. (Repeat several times.)

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes! You've got it totally memorized now! Way to go! Today we are celebrating Easter, and that is a HAPPY DAY! In today's lesson from the Bible (hold up Bible), we learn that Jesus came to live among us because He wants to be our friend forever. He knew He was going to go away, and He knew He was coming back. He told His friends that was what was going to happen and it did. Jesus came back. He is alive. Are you ready to hear our story? (Pause) Great! I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a single minute of our Bible lesson!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Great job listening, everyone! Do you remember from last week what the people shouted as Jesus entered Jerusalem? (Pause) You are right! They shouted Hosanna! Hosanna! Yeah Jesus! Yeah Jesus, and thank you so much for Easter! Let's sing Hosanna Rocks right now."

Lead children in singing "Hosanna Rock" and "Nobody Loves Me Like You".

WORSHIP LEADER: One last time before we leave, **Who can you follow?**"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "I can follow Jesus!"

WORSHIP LEADER: I hope you have a great week. I'll see you next time!"
