1. CONNECT GAME:

Sit in a circle with your group and explain that another word for a fear is *phobia*. Tell them all phobias have an official name. For example, the fear of spiders is officially called arachnophobia. Then see if they can guess what the following phobia names mean from the choices you give them.

1. Is **ablutophobia** the fear of (a) cats, (b) taking a bath or (c) balloons?
2. Is **chorophobia** the fear of (a) dancing, (b) singing or (c) hopping?
3. Is **cyclophobia** the fear of (a) tornados, (b) bicycles or (c) unicycles?
4. Is **lachanophobia** the fear of (a) ice cream, (b) fruit or (c) vegetables?
5. Is **nephophobia** the fear of (a) sunshine, (b) rainbows or (c) clouds?

2. BIBLE LESSON:

If you were here with us last week, you'll remember that Jesus helped Peter catch a whole net of fish Peter after a tough night of fishing. Peter was so amazed by what Jesus did, that he left everything to follow Him.
