# Water From a Rock Review Craft:

What You Need: Rock and Moses picture (one per kid), water fall picture, scissors, crayons



#### What You Do:

Give each child a paper and a waterfall picture. Have them cut a slit along the black line with their scissors. Color then picture and waterfall and then insert the top of the waterfall in the slit and fold over in the back to hold it in place. Ask review questions as the kids work:

#### **Questions:**

- In today's Bible story, what did the Israelites do when they ran out of water? (They complained and thought about killing Moses)
- How did God provide the Israelites with water? (From a rock)
- Today we learned that we should Dare to \_\_\_\_\_? (Trust)
- Our main point for today is "In order to have Daring Faith, I need to trust God to provide for my\_\_\_\_\_? (Needs)

#### What You Say:

"Great job remembering our story today. If we are going to have Daring Faith, we need to TRUST what God to provide for our needs."

### You Need it, You Got it

What You Need: Small white board, and a few dry erase markers

#### What You Do:

Have a volunteer think of something God provides for us and draw it on the white board. Hold it up and let the other kids try and guess what it is. Once they guess it, let another kid draw something else. Continue the game until all the kids who want to draw something get a turn. If kids have trouble

thinking of something here are some examples: house, clothes, water, food, school, teacher, family, Jesus, church, Bible, animals, etc.

#### What You Say:

Today we talked about trusting God to meet our needs. We know we can trust God because we can see how he met the needs of people all through the Bible just he did for like the Israelites.

# **Rock Memory Verse Game**

What You Need: One set of rocks with one word from the verse written on each rock

#### What You Do:

Have the children sit in a circle. The object of the game is to pick up all the rocks in the correct order. Each child takes a turn picking up as many rocks as he can and turning them over one at a time. If he picks up a rock out of order, he turns all the rocks over and the next child takes a turn. The first child to pick up all the rocks in order wins.

# Pray

#### What You Say:
