DARE TO BELIEVE

WEEK 1

WORSHIP LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm so glad you are here to sing and learn with me. Are you ready to have some fun learning that we can have Daring Faith because we can BELIEVE that God has a plan for us? (Pause.) When I say, 'Who has a plan for you?' you say, 'God has a plan for me. (Point up with both index fingers) I can BELIEVE (Clasp hands together)' Let's try it. Who has a plan for you? WORSHIP LEADER: "Great job! You guys are awesome! I've got some really fun songs for us to sing this month. Let's sing!"

Lead children in singing "Praise the Lord Everyday" and "Live Differently" this month's worship songs.

"What incredible singers you are! This is going to be an AWESOME month!! Who has a plan for you? God has a plan for me. (Point up with both index fingers) I can BELIEVE (Clasp hands together)"

WORSHIP LEADER: "That's right! God has a plan for me and we can BELIEVE in God's plan and have a DARING FAITH. In fact, the Bible tells us just that. Let's learn our new memory verse. Watch me say it and do the motions, and then you can do it with me. 'Be on your guard. Remain strong in the faith. Be brave.' 1 Corinthians 16:13."

WORSHIP LEADER: "All month long we are going to be learning about a man named Joseph. Joseph was a very special boy. He was SO special that his dad gave him an awesome coat. Not only did God make Joseph special, He made each and every one of us special too. I can't wait to hear all about Joseph and how God had a plan for his life. Are you ready for our Bible lesson, I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a single minute of our Bible story!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Great job listening! God has a plan for us. No matter where we are or what's happening, He is there with us and He wants us to use the things that make us special to help others. Even though you are little you are never to little to help. What are some ways you can help at home this week? (Let several children answer.) I DARE all of you to help out at home this week and don't forget that God will help you. Hey, we have a song that says just that?
