Opening Game (Daring Faith Challenge):

"When we say that God is our rock, we're talking about how we can use Him and His teachings as a foundation for our lives. In these verses in Matthew Jesus is basically saying, it doesn't do any good to just READ the Bible. We have to DO what it says! God gave us his word so that we would use it! We need to read it to learn how to have Daring Faith."

Explain Daring Faith Booklets:

I have something very exciting to tell you about now. We want to see how Daring YOU are! We have a challenge for EVERYONE to participate in this month. And IF you finish the challenge you will win a very valuable prize! How many people like to go to Water parks in the summer??? Well, we are getting closer to the summer and if you commit to this challenge you will win a pass to a local Water Park!
