

CITY: End Of Year Party - MAY 28th/29th

Hey Leaders! We will have our annual End of Year Party in the CITY. Please come prepared to have fun!! BE ready to join in and play as many games as you can. This is another GREAT opportunity to hang out and have fun and CONNECT with your kids!!! Below is the list of games we will be playing.

LARGE GROUP: When Kindergarteners ARRIVE:

All In – Each grade is a team. Balls all have a number 1,2,3. 1st grade collects the number 1 balls, 2nd grade collects number 2 balls and 3rd grade collects number 3 balls.

On Go – kids will have 1 minute to run to find their number ball and run to put them in their pool. Team with the most balls wins. (We can play 2 rounds)

Mr. or Mrs. Fox –

Can you outfox the Fox?

The object of the game is to walk past Mrs. (or Mr.) Fox without getting caught.

To play, pick someone to be the Fox. Everyone else should line up on the starting line.

The Fox will stand about 20 feet away with her back turned.

The rest of the players say, "What time is it Mrs. (or Mr.) Fox?"

If Mrs. (or Mr.) Fox answers a time like, "It's five o'clock" players take five steps forward. If she answers, "It's one o'clock" players take one step forward, and so on. The players can take any size step they want.

If Mrs. Fox says, "It's time to eat you!" she turns around and chases the other players back to the starting line.

If Mrs. Fox catches someone, he becomes the next Fox.
