### 2. CONNECT GAME: Circles

#### What You Do:

- Play an elimination game where the kids gather in circles of a certain number of people who have one thing in common.
- You will call out a number and then the thing in common. Then kids will scramble to get into those specific groups.
- For example:
  - "Circles of three people who have noses!" (In this example everyone would be involved because everyone has a nose!)
  - All the kids (with noses) would form circles of three and join hands with the people in their group.
  - No more than three and no less. Anyone left out of the circles is out for that round.
- Keep calling out different numbers of people in circles and different common qualities. The qualities should not always involve everyone. For example: "Circles of two with blonde hair!" Only those with blonde hair would have to get in circles. Everyone else is safe.
- Here are some examples of qualities to call out: blue shirts, wearing jeans, wearing a dress, has glasses, wearing clothes, in second grade (or third grade), eight years old, is at Parkview has hair, etc.
