

Who-Am-I?

Supplies: Cards, Masking tape.

- Have each one of the kids take a note card without looking at it. You will then give them a small piece of tape, so it can stick to their foreheads.
- Then tell them that they are to gather together into groups based on characteristics of their animals (animals that are four legged, same species, farm-animals), but they can't talk.
- They should pull each other and be confused that some people are trying to get into a group while they don't fit in the categories. Ultimately, they all belong in the same group and in the same way we all belong to Jesus' family.
- Note: we want to get the kids to understand they are in one large group,
 - What was hard about getting people in the same group as you?
 - What did you do when you saw someone trying to get your group that you thought shouldn't be?
 - In the same way, do you think apostles had a hard time letting Cornelius into God's kingdom?

Possible animals: Cow, Alligator, Lion, Cat, Shark, Snake, Chicken, Panda, Sheep, and Parrot.

Look up and read Ephesians 1:7

- How would you explain this verse to a friend?
- Could you give an example of forgiveness? What happened after you asked or gave forgiveness?
- Forgiveness allows us to fix broken friendships with God, family, and friends. Who is someone you think God wants us to forgive?
- Who is someone you could invite into God's Kingdom?
