### **SFX: Greeter Theme**

**HOST:** "Welcome to our summer series called ZAPPED! We have been following the life of Peter to see what it means to be ZAPPED by God's power. Peter had some amazing things happen in his life because he was plugged into God's power.

#### Host:

One day last summer, I had some people over to my house. This was as ordinary of a day as a day could be. The sun was out, the sidewalk was boiling hot, and we were hanging out at the pool with not a care in the world. It started to get really hot and we knew that we needed to get inside to the air conditioning. Some of the people who were at my house went home, but my brother stayed and so did my best friend. We went into the kitchen to get some food.

As we were in the kitchen, I noticed something peculiar out of the corner of my eye. My iPad was on the counter in the kitchen, and next to it was a huge one-liter bottle of water. It startled me a bit, but I really didn't think anything of it. But I thought, "Hmmmm. Is there any chance of that water bottle falling over? Nahhhhh." After a few minutes our conversation moved to the kitchen where, as friends and brothers will, we started rough-housing in the kitchen. Now, I know none of you have ever rough-housed in the kitchen. Am I right, or am I right?

It started to get a little out of control and before I knew it, my brother and my best friend fell into the one-liter bottle of water and it spilled all over my iPad.

I was furious! I couldn't believe what I had just seen! I immediately lunged for my iPad but it was too late. #### **ZAPPED GAME:**

**Create a Camel:** Basically, this game is group Charades. Have the kids form groups of five to nine. The Host will call out an object and the groups are to create that object with their bodies. Once you give them enough time, you can have the Host and/or small group leaders judge and declare someone the winner. The group who wins the most rounds wins the game. Example: Ant, Bear, Camel, lighting bolt, toaster, and etc.

Note: for younger kids, have them lay down on the ground then holding each other up.
