LG OVERVIEW

DAVID AND JONATHAN

WORSHIP LEADER: “Hello, friends! It’s so good to see you! I’m super excited because this month we’re going to be celebrating our good friends. And all our Toy Story friends from Andy’s room are here (*Point to Woody, Buzz and Rex*) to help us learn what friendship is all about. Raise your hand if you have seen the movie Toy Story? (*Pause and raise your hand*) Me too, it’s my favorite! Can you tell me who was Woody’s good friend? (*Pause and point to Buzz*) Yes! Can you tell me who was Buzz’s good friend? (*Pause and point to Woody*). Yes you are right! Woody and Buzz were good friends. Can you point to one of your good friends? (*Pause.*) Yes! All of our good friends are right here. And guess who gave you these good friends! God did! When I say, ‘**Who gives you good friends?**’ you say, ‘**God gives me good friends!**’ Let’s try it. **Who gives you good friends?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**God gives me good friends!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Great job! You guys are awesome! Let’s sing!”

Lead children in singing “I Like To” and “Together” this month’s new worship song.

“What incredible singers you are! This is going to be a fantastic month! **Who gives you good friends?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**God gives me good friends!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “That’s right! **God gives me good friends!** In fact, our memory verse tells us that doing things with friends is best! Let’s learn it. Watch me say it and do the motions, and then you can do it with me. ‘Two people are better than one. They can help each other in everything they do’, Ecclesiastes 4:9. Let’s try that together.” (*Repeat several times.*)

WORSHIP LEADER: “Today’s lesson is about two very good friends from the Bible named David and Jonathan. They loved each other and helped each other when they needed it. They were the best of friends. Everyone needs good friends who love them and help them. Let’s watch our video lesson and find out more about these *TWO* friends (*make the number two with your fingers*). I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a single minute of our story!”
