1. WORSHIP ON THE SCREENS

CG: Highwire

2. CONNECT GAME: Tick Tac Toe Relay

• Divide the room in half with 9 hula hoops set up like a tic tac toe board in the middle. Give one side 3 red shirts and the other side 3 blue shirts. They play a relay game where the first child from each team runs and puts the shirt in a hoop. They then tag the next person who does the same. Once all three shirts are down, if no one has tic tac toe, they continue in a relay form this time PICKING UP one of their shirts and movie it to a open hoop. Continue until someone wins.
