# ACTIVITY 1

## DAVID AND JONATHAN

### Story Time

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some kids (*especially the younger ones*) may wander. That's OK. They're still listening and learning!

**What You Need:** "D," "J," "King," and "Stuff" from the Activity Pages found on the Website, cardstock, and scissors

**What You Say:** "Boys and girls, help me act out the story of David and Jonathan. (*Hold up 'D' and 'J.'*) David and Jonathan were friends. David worked for King Saul (*hold up 'King'*) and Jonathan was the king's son. But they were still best friends. David and Jonathan ate together (*put picture of food near D and J*) and had fun together. (*Put picture of toys near D and J.*) When Jonathan would tell David something important, (*lean J toward D*) he knew that David wouldn't tell anyone else. They truly were best buds. They shared everything. Jonathan gave David the robe off his back. (*Lay down the robe.*) And he gave him his sword. (*Lay down the sword.*) And he gave him his bow. (*Lay down the bow.*) Jonathan even gave David his belt! David loved Jonathan. And Jonathan loved David. They both wanted to honor God and they knew that God had given them each other as friends.
