LG OVERVIEW

MOSES AND THE WATER

WORSHIP LEADER (*wearing camping outfit with backpack*): “Yay! I’m so glad to see you today! It’s so much fun to sing with you. We are going to hear another great part of Moses’ story today, but first let’s practice our Bottom Line. **Whose way is perfect? God’s way is perfect!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Yes, it is! Let’s sing about it.”

Lead children in singing “Super Wonderful” and “Whatever, Wherever”

“Great singing, my friends. Remember, **God’s way is perfect! Whose way is perfect?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: **God’s way is perfect!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Exactly. **God’s way is perfect!** Let’s review our memory verse. ‘God’s way is perfect’, 2 Samuel 22:31. Let’s try that together.” (*Repeat several times.*)

WORSHIP LEADER: “Let’s jump right into our true story from the Bible. (*Hold up Bible.*) The story today is about God’s people, the Israelites, and their leader Moses who had been on a great adventure. They believed that God’s way was perfect so they followed him. Remember, the Israelites ran away from the mean king Pharaoh and God led them right through the Red Sea. It had been quite the adventure, but now they were in the desert. And they are very tired of traveling!”

“Have you ever had to walk for a really long time somewhere and complained to your mom or dad or whoever you were with that you were *tiiiiired*? (*Pause.*) You were thinking, ‘When is this going to end and when can I sit and rest and have a snack?’ Right? Well, this is exactly what was happening to the Israelites. They were tired of traveling and tired of walking. They were hot and probably sweaty and dirty. They wanted it to end! And they were thirsty. So they started grumbling to Moses for water. That means they were complaining and whining. ‘Don’t grumble at me,’ Moses said. Everyone say ‘Don’t grumble at me!’ (*Listen.*) Great job! But the people didn’t listen. They told Moses they didn’t think God’s way was perfect anymore! They were thirsty ... and tired! And they wished they were back with the mean Pharaoh because at least HE gave them water! OH NO, what do you think happens next? We better watch our video lesson and find out what happens to Moses and the Israelites. I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a single minute of our Bible lesson!”

WORSHIP LEADER: “That was *greeeat*! Moses went out in front of the people and God told him to strike the big rock with his staff. Amazing! Three cheers for God! Say hip-hip-hooray with me 3 times. Ready? Go! (*Listen*) I told you that story was great. And that’s because God is great. Now it’s time to sing some more songs! Sing ‘Great Big God’ with me!”

Lead children in singing “Great Big God” and “Who Knows Best”

“Wasn’t that a fun song? I love that one. Moses trusted God and went His way. We can too. **Whose way is perfect? God’s way is perfect!**”
