

## LG OVERVIEW HEALING THE DEAF MAN

Leading Large Group is so much fun! Why limit this experience to just one person. As such, the script is broken into three parts...Worship Leader, Bible Verse and Host!

If only one Large Group leader is scheduled simply follow the script, however, if there is more than one Large Group leader scheduled or if there are other volunteers interested in helping, this script can be done by two or three people.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** Worship Leader will use this colored text. This person is responsible for welcoming the children, reviewing the Bottom Line and introducing the worship songs!

**BIBLE VERSE:** This person is responsible for teaching and reviewing the Memory Verse. (Large Group leaders invite a friend to say the Bible verse with the children, remember two are better than one! This is a great way to invite other volunteers to help lead Large Group!)

**HOST:** Host will use this colored text. This person is responsible for introducing the Bible lesson.

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Yay! I'm so glad to see you today! It's so much fun to sing with you. We've been learning about someone who is with us ALL THE TIME. Who is it? (*Pause.*) Yes! Jesus is always with us. **Who is there when you need Him?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Great job! Let's sing!"

(Lead children in singing "My God is Number One" and "Super Wonderful".)

"Great singing, my friends. Remember, **Jesus is there when I need Him. Who is there when you need Him?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

**BIBLE VERSE:** "Exactly. **Jesus is there when I need Him.** It's time to practice our memory verse. Are you ready? *You are everything I need,* Psalm 119:57. Do it with me. (Repeat several times.)

"You are all AMAZING at that verse! Have you shown your parents yet? How about your brother and sister? How about all your good friends? Make sure you show them today!"

**HOST:** "Today we are going to hear a TRUE story from the Bible about a deaf man that was healed by Jesus! The deaf man couldn't hear. His ears didn't work. He needed help. Jesus had the power to help him! How do you think Jesus helped the deaf man? (*Pause.*) Let's watch our video lesson and find out. I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a single minute of our Bible lesson!"

**HOST:** "If Jesus has the power to make a deaf man hear again, He has the power to be there when we need Him? Friends, Jesus will be there whenever you need Him. Tell me: **Who is there when you need Him? Jesus is there when I need Him.** 

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Are you ready to sing another song with me? (*Pause.*) You are? Let's sing."

(Lead children in singing "My Best Friend.")

"Awesome singing, friends. Now, remind me: Who is there when you need Him?"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "That's right! And don't you forget it! See you next week!"
