### • Connect Game: Popcorn toss

You will need a lot of paper for the kids to make popcorn balls. You will also need some masking tape to divide the room in half. Split the kids into two teams. Give each side a minute or two to make as many balls of paper as they can. When you say go, they will throw as many pieces of popcorn to the other side. When you say stop, the round is over, which ever side has more popcorn on their side, loses the round. If any kid throws after you say stop, they lose the round for their team. The team that has won the most rounds wins the game.

Make sure to hold on to the paper for the small group game, "Get It Out."
