

The Alley Rundown- April 1st/2nd

“Jesus wants me to put others first by serving them.”

Pre-Show GOAL!

1. Worship on the screens

CG: GOAL!

2. Connect Game: Hike the toilet paper

Select two kids from each grade to represent their age group. Explain to them that they will be practicing their football hikes for the fall. They will be hiking toilet paper instead. Have the teams stand at least 10 ft. apart. Have them hike the ball between their legs to each other and see how many times they can get it back and forth in two minutes. If they drop it, it's a dead ball. (You might want to have a small group leader help count for one of the teams to keep track) The team with most successful catches wins. *Note: You will want to loosen the toilet paper so that it unwinds as they throw.*

3. Playing Bible Lesson: Story of Jesus washing the Disciples feet

“Hey Parkview Kids, how are you doing today? (*Pause for Response*) My name is [Host's name] and I am glad you are here today. We are starting a brand new series called GOOOAL! (*Put hands in the air like you scored*) Can you guys say that with me? GOOOAL!! Awesome! When do you normally hear the word goal? That's right, usually at a sports game. On the count of three, I want everyone to tell me what your favorite team is, ready, 1,2,3. (*Pause for response*) Nice, mine is the [sport's team name]. What is so cool about a sports team is that all these different people come together to do one thing; win. However, everyone has a way of trying to get that done and often times that creates conflict.”

“We all have that teammate who thinks they are all that, right? You know, that one player who likes to hog the ball and never passes to anyone. Maybe it's someone who likes to blame everyone else on the team for losing the game. I don't know about you, but those people drive me crazy! Those people only think of themselves and often times take credit for something they didn't do. That person needs humility and A LOT of it. Well, humility is what we are talking about this month. How many of you have ever heard of the word humility before? (*Pause for response*) Well, here's the definition to help us get on the same page.”

“Putting others first by giving up what you think you deserve.”

“Humility is putting someone else first and not ourselves. When you don't think to put others first, you are failing to be humble. This is huge because humility is something that is very important when you're following Jesus. Jesus was someone who put other people first and in today's story we are going to see how Jesus does that by serving his disciples. So face towards the screen and check out today's video.”

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4. Ask Relate Questions:

- What was the grossest thing you have ever had to clean?
- Why does Jesus want us to serve others? (*He wants us to be humble like him and to care for other people*)
- How does serving help make you humble? (*Helps you understand humility itself*).
- What's a way we can put someone else before ourselves this week?
