LG OVERVIEW

PALM SUNDAY

WORSHIP LEADER: “Good morning, everyone! It’s so good to see you today. I can’t wait to sing with you today. But first tell me: **Who is the best?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**Jesus is the best!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Yes, that’s right!! Let’s sing.

(Lead children in singing “Shout” and “Praise the Lord Everyday”).

“Yay! What incredible singers you are. **Who is the best?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**Jesus is the best!**”

BIBLE VERSE: “That’s right! **Jesus is the best!** Remember, our memory verse this month tells us that God gave us Jesus because He loves us SO MUCH! Are you ready to do it with me? *(Pause.)* Let’s do it! ‘*God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son, John 3:16.*’” *(Repeat several times.)*

HOST: “I’m so happy to see you all today, because I have such an exciting story to tell you. You can read this story in the Bible *(hold up Bible)*, which means it’s true! Everything we read in the Bible is true always. Our Bible story today begins in the town of Jerusalem. That’s a crazy name, Can you say ‘Jerusalem’ with me? *(Pause)* Jerusalem. Excellent. Now, the people in Jerusalem heard that Jesus was coming! Can you imagine if YOU heard that Jesus, God’s Son, was coming to your town? Would you go see Him? *(Pause.)* I wonder what the people of Jerusalem did? Let’s watch our video lesson and find out. I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a single minute of our Bible lesson!”

HOST: “When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the people all gathered in the street to praise Jesus together. They waved branches and shouted, ‘Hosanna! Hosanna! Yay, Jesus! Say that with me: ‘Hosanna! Hosanna! Yay, Jesus!’”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Wonderful! I have a special song that says Hosanna. Let’s sing it right now!”

(Lead children in singing “Hosanna Rock.”)
