HAPPY EASTER

WORSHIP LEADER: “Yay! I’m so glad to see you today! It’s so much fun to sing with you. It is a very special day! It’s the day we celebrate Easter! That’s when we celebrate that Jesus is alive. He is the best! **Who is the best?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “Jesus is the best!”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Great job! Let’s sing some songs.”

(Lead children in singing “Praise the Lord Everyday” and “Shout”.)

“Great singing, my friends. Remember, **Jesus is the best! Who is the best?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “Jesus is the best!”

BIBLE VERSE: “Exactly. **Jesus is the best!** It’s time to practice our memory verse. Are you ready? ‘God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son, John 3:16.’” (Repeat several times.) You are all AMAZING at that verse! Great job!”

HOST: “I am so excited to see so many friends here today because today I have the most amazing TRUE story to tell you from the Bible. (*Hold up Bible.*) In fact, today’s true story is the greatest story ever! But I’ll go ahead and warn you, there are happy parts (*hold up the happy face emoji beach ball*) and there are sad parts (*hold up the sad face emoji beach ball*). Are you ready to hear today’s true Bible story? (*Pause.*) Okay! Let’s watch our video lesson right now. I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a single minute of our Bible story!”

Watch Video Lesson

HOST: “Can you believe it? Jesus is alive! He came back just like He said He would. He loves us SOOO much, and he wants to be our friend forever! Doesn’t that make you SO happy? (*Hold up the happy face emoji beach ball.*) Let me see your happy faces!”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Easter is an oh so happy day because today we celebrate that Jesus is alive and He loves us. In fact, nobody loves us as much as Jesus. Let’s sing that song now!”

(Lead children in singing “Nobody loves me like You.”)

“Awesome singing, friends. Now remind me: **Who is the best?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “Jesus is the best!”

WORSHIP LEADER: “That’s right! And don’t you forget it! See you next week!”
