

The Alley Rundown- April 29th/30th

“Jesus wants me to put others first.”

CG:Pre-Show

1. Worship on the screens

CG: GOOOAL!

2. **Connect Game:** Circle Dodge Ball

Have the kids form a circle. Try to limit each group to around 20-25 kids. Pick one kid to be the “King” and the other to be the “body guard.” The kids have to try to hit the king in the middle of the room with a single dodge ball. However, both the king and the outer circle are not allowed to move. Only the Bodyguard can move around the circle to block the ball.

3. **Playing Bible Lesson: Philippians 2:3**

“Parkview Kids, how are you doing today? *(Pause)* Awesome, my name is [Host’s name] and welcome to the Alley. This is the last week of our series called GOOAL! If you could be on any sports team, which would it be and which position? Awesome, we have been talking about humility all month. Here’s our definition.”

“Putting others first by giving up what you think you deserve.”

“Humility can sometimes be hard to do because we want to put ourselves before other people all the time. We tend to make things about us and get the spotlight on us. Like we all imagine scoring the game winning point right before we score the game winning point.”

“It’s alright to have dreams or even to be the best at something. However, we must not forget to put others first. It doesn’t matter how great you are, you can always put someone else first. Now, you might be thinking, why would I want to put others first? I don’t really want to give up what’s mine or give others what belongs to me.”

“You know what, I can understand that, but we choose to put others first because Jesus put himself before us. Ultimately we want to be like Jesus and becoming humble is how we can do that. I think today’s video will be able to explain it a little bit better than I can.”

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4. **Ask Relate Questions:**

- If you had a time machine, where would you go and why?
- Put humility in your own words. How would you describe it to someone else?
- What are some ways for us to be humble? *HINT: think about this past month. (Serving others, holding the door for someone, putting away laundry, letting someone else get the glory, etc.).*
