LG OVERVIEW

HAGAR

WORSHIP LEADER: “Good morning, everyone! It’s so good to see you today. I can’t wait to sing with you today. But first tell me: **Who’s got it?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**God’s got it.**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Yes, that’s right! Let’s sing some songs about our Great Big God.”

(Lead children in singing “Great Big God” and “I Like To”.)

“Yay! What incredible singers you are. **Who’s got it?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**God’s got it.**”

BIBLE VERSE: “That’s right! **God’s got it.** Remember, our memory verse this month tells us all about our great and mighty Father, our awesome King. Are you ready to do it with me? *(Pause.)* Let’s do it! ‘*He is the great God, the mighty and awesome God, Deuteronomy 10:17.*’ Let’s do it again.”

HOST: “*(Enter carrying a Bible.)* Hello, friends. Does everyone have your listening ears on? Great! I have a true story to tell you from the Bible *(hold up Bible)*, but I need your help. Are you ready? Here we go. Our story begins in the desert with a mom named Hagar and her son. The desert was HOT. Everyone, please show me what you look like when you’re hot! *(Wipe your brow, pull on the neck of your shirt as if you’re fanning yourself, etc.)* But Hagar and her son weren’t just hot. They were also hungry and they had no water. What are they going to do? Where are they going to get food and water? *(Pause)* Let’s watch our video lesson and find out. I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a minute of our Bible lesson!”

HOST: “Wow, did you hear that! An angel told Hagar that God heard her son’s cry and they should not be afraid. Wow! And God provided a well full of water. They had nothing to worry about! God was with them the whole time! So you don’t have to worry because God always hears you! **God’s got it. Who’s got it? God’s got it!**”
