LG OVERVIEW

SAMUEL

WORSHIP LEADER: "Good morning, everyone! It's so good to see you today. I can't wait to sing with you. But first tell me: **Who can do what God wants you to do?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "I can do it!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes, that's right! Let's sing some songs about how our Great Big God Rocks!"

Lead children in singing "Great Big God" and "God does Great Things".

"Yay! What incredible singers you are. **Who can do what God wants you to do?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "I can do it!"

BIBLE VERSE: "That's right! **I can do what God wants me to do.** Remember, our memory verse this month tells us all about how we rock because we can do good works! Are you ready to do it with me? (Pause.) Let's do it! *God made us to do good works*, Ephesians 2:10. Let's do it again." (Repeat several times.)

STORYTELLER: "Hello, friends! I have a super cool story to tell you straight from the Bible. (*Hold up Bible.*) And you know if it's in the Bible, it's true! Now, this true Bible story takes place at bedtime. I love bedtime. I love to get into my most comfiest pajamas and grab my favorite plush animal and my softest blanket. I just love it! There once was a boy named Samuel who lived in the temple. One night, Samuel was going to sleep and he heard someone call him, 'Samuel, Samuel.' I wonder who was calling him? Let's watch our video lesson and find out. I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a minute of our Bible lesson!"

STORYTELLER: "Wow! Isn't that awesome? Even though Samuel was a kid just like you, he learned to listen to God. And we can too! God talks to us through the Bible. He tells us all sorts of BIG things we should do even though we are just kids. He tells us to love others. He tells us to listen to our parents. And He tells us to share what we have. These are all good things that God wants us to do, and we can do them because why? Because **KIDS ROCK!** Say that with me!"

CHILDREN and STORYTELLER: "Kids ROCK!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "God made you, and wants you to love one another! Let's sing about that."

Lead children in singing "Love One Another."

"I love singing with you. Now tell me one last time, **who can do what God wants you to do?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "I can do it!"

WORSHIP LEADER: "That's the truth friends - And don't you forget it! See you next week!"
