# The ALLEY SG- Week of August 5-6, 2017

#### **Supplies Needed:**

One medium storage box (1 per group)

Three small pieces of paper for each player

Pencils, pens, crayons, or markers

One plastic spoon for each player

## 1) Let Her Rip

- Say, "This game is called Let Her Rip. This game will help us remember to let go of everything
  in our lives that keeps us from serving God."
- Hand out 3 small pieces of paper and a pencil to each player
- Ask the players, "Think of three things in your life that you need to let go of so that you can have a heart after God" (category ideas: time, talent, treasure)
- Ask the players to write or draw one answer on each of their pieces of paper
- Begin Round #1
- Split the small group into two teams
- One player from each team plays in round #1
- Players stand next to each other shoulder to shoulder
- Hand a plastic spoon to each player
- Place the bin on the ground at least 5 feet in front of the players
- Player #1 reads the answers on his/her papers
- Player #1 crumples up his/her papers and uses the plastic spoon to catapult them one at a time into the plastic box
- Player receives 5 points for each basket made
- The remaining players then take a turn
- The player with the most points wins the round for his/her team
- Begin round #2
- Repeat all steps for round #2
- Repeat all steps for more rounds as time and interest permit

• Bonus Round: Move the box further away for bonus rounds

#### 2) Review Questions:

- a. How would you feel if God chose you to be King/Queen?
- b. What would be the first thing you would do?
- c. What do you think God would want you to do?
- d. How can you commit more of yourself to God?
- e. What are some distractions that take away time from you and Jesus?
