RAHAB AND THE SPIES

WORSHIP LEADER: “Yay! I’m so glad to see you today! It’s so much fun to sing with you. This month is so fun. I love learning how to be a Super Kid with you. And we can all be Super Kids because God is with each and every one of us. **Who is always with you?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**God is always with me.**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Great job! Let’s sing!”

Lead children in singing “Superhero” and “Wherever, Whatever”

“Great singing, my friends. Remember, **God is always with me. Who is always with you?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**God is always with me.**”

BIBLE VERSE: “Exactly. **God is always with me.** It’s time to practice our memory verse. Are you ready? *Be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid . . . , for the LORD your God goes with you,* Deuteronomy 31:6. Do that with me. *(Repeat several times.)* You are all AMAZING at that verse! Have you shown your parents yet? How about your brother and sister? How about all your good friends? Make sure you show them today!”

STORYTELLER: *(Hold Bible open.)* “Our lesson today is about this girl.”

(Pull out Rahab stand-up character and prop it up for the children to see.)

“Her name is Rahab. Can you say hi to Rahab? *(Pause for responses.)* Rahab’s story is right here in this book. *(Hold up Bible.)* Do you remember what book this is? *(Pause.)* Yes! The Bible! The Bible has God’s stories in it, which means they are always true! Rahab’s story really happened a long time ago. Are you ready to learn more about Rahab? *(Pause.)* I am. I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a minute of our Bible lesson.”

“Rahab and her family were kept safe, all because she had the **COURAGE** to do the right thing. She kept the spies safe, and they kept her safe. That is what made her **SUPER COURAGEOUS**, which is why I like to call her ‘Rahab the Courageous.’ And you know what? God wants you to have courage to do what He says, just like Rahab did. And when you do, God will be with you and make **YOU** a super courageous kid too! **Who is always with you?**”

CHILDREN and STORYTELLER: “**God is always with me!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Are you ready to sing another song with me? *(Pause.)* You are? Let’s sing about our God, who is number one.”

Lead children in singing “My God Is Number One.”

“Way to go, friends. Now remind me: **Who is always with you? God is always with me.**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “That’s the truth friends - And don’t you forget it! See you next week!”
