LG OVERVIEW

AARON HELPS MOSES

WORSHIP LEADER: “Hello, friends! It’s so good to see you! I’m super excited because we’re going to be talking about being thankful! I can think of a WHOLE bunch of things I’m thankful for, but mostly I’m thankful for the people in my life. **I am thankful for people who help me!** Whoop! I’m so excited. And, when I ask you this very important question, **‘Who are you thankful for?’** I want you to say, **‘I am thankful for people who help me!’** Let’s try it. **Who are you thankful for?’**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**I am thankful for people who help me!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “Great job! You guys are awesome! Let’s sing!”

Lead children in singing “Praise the Lord Everyday” and “Together”.

“What incredible singers you are! This is going to be a fantastic month! **Who are you thankful for?’**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**I am thankful for people who help me!**”

BIBLE VERSE: “That’s right! **I am thankful for people who help me!** In fact, our memory verse says just that. Watch me say it and do the motions, and then you can do it with me. *Always give thanks to God,* Ephesians 5:20. Let’s try that together.” *(Repeat several times.)*

STORYTELLER: “Friends, today’s TRUE Bible story is super cool. *(Hold up Bible.)* It’s about a battle and friends and good guys and bad guys. It’s totally awesome! So the Israelites—those are the good guys—had to battle against the bad guys. I wonder who will win? Are you ready to hear our story and find out, when I count to three, yell, ‘Tell me a story!’ Ready? One, two, three! *(Pause)* Awesome! I better go grab a seat so I don’t miss a minute of the Bible lesson.”

STORYTELLER: “What an awesome story! I loved how Aaron, Moses’ brother, chose to help him. Our families help us too, don’t they? That’s what we’ll be talking about for the next couple of weeks. We are SO thankful for people who help us! **Who are you thankful for? I am thankful for people who help me. Who are you thankful for?’**”

CHILDREN and STORYTELLER: “**I am thankful for people who help me.”**

WORSHIP LEADER: “Great job, everyone! I’ve got another song that I can’t wait to sing with you. Let’s go!”

Lead children in singing “Woohoo I Can Help You.”

WORSHIP LEADER: “We are going to have so much fun learning about helping and thanking! **Who are you thankful for?’**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**I am thankful for people who help me!**”

WORSHIP LEADER: “That’s the truth friends - And don’t you forget it! See you next week!”
