WOMAN AT

THE WELL

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "Good morning, friends! It's a new month, and I'm so excited to see you today. During this month, we are going to celebrate love. Do you know who loves you so much? (Pause.) Yes, Jesus loves you. In fact, Jesus loves you and you and you and you. (Point around room.) **Jesus loves everyone!** When I ask you this very important question, '**Who does Jesus love?**' I want you to say, '**Jesus loves everyone.**' Let's try it. **Who does Jesus love?**'"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "**Jesus loves everyone.**"

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "Great job! Let's sing about how Jesus loves us and wants us to love everyone."

(Lead children in singing "Love One Another" and "Great Big God".)

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "Yes! Jesus loves us and is **ALWAYS** there for us! Isn't that awesome? And Jesus doesn't just love you and me. **Jesus loves everyone. Who does Jesus love?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "**Jesus loves everyone.**"

BIBLE VERSE: "That's right! **Jesus loves everyone.** Our memory verse is all about Jesus' love. It says: *Love each other as I have loved you*, John 15:12. Let's try that together. (Repeat several times.)"

STORYTELLER: "I'm very glad to see you here today, because I have an amazing **TRUE** story to share with you. So our **TRUE** story begins at a well. At a what? A well? A long time ago when someone was thirsty and needed a drink of water, they couldn't just go to a faucet in their home, or open the fridge, or even go to a store for water. See, back then when you were thirsty, you had to bring a jar and walk and walk and walk to the town well to get water. One day, Jesus had been traveling a long way and he was hot and tired and very thirsty. So, He went to the town well, but Jesus was missing something super important—something he needs to **GET** the water. I wonder what it is. Let's watch our video lesson to find out."

STORYTELLER: "Jesus didn't have a jar to get a drink of water from the well. So, Jesus asked the woman at the well for a drink that day. She gave Jesus a drink. Jesus took the time to speak to her even though she was different. **Everyone is different and Jesus loves us ALL no matter what! Who does Jesus love? Jesus loves everyone!"**

PRAYER: "Yes! I'm so glad to know that even though we're all different, **Jesus loves everyone.** Let's pray and thank God for sending Jesus!"

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "Great job, everyone! Because Jesus loves us, we can love others. And we can praise Jesus and thank Him for His love and all that He does for us. In fact, we can praise Jesus every day! Let's sing about that!"

(Lead children in singing "Praise the Lord Everyday.")

"I love praising Jesus together with you! He is **AMAZING**, and He loves us all so much. **Who does Jesus love?"**

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "**Jesus loves everyone.**"
