# LG OVERVIEW

## PETER'S DENIAL AND RESTORATION

**WORSHIP LEADER/HOST:** "Hello, hello, friends. It's so great to see you today! I'm so excited, and I can't wait to sing with you. But first tell me: **Who does Jesus love?**"

**CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER:** "Jesus loves everyone."

**WORSHIP LEADER/HOST:** "Yes! **Jesus loves everyone.** He loves you and you and you and you. He loves everyone! Let's sing a song all about that."

*(Lead children in singing "God is Big and He Loves Me" and "Love One Another")*

**WORSHIP LEADER/HOST:** "Wonderful singing, my friends. Tell me: **Who does Jesus love?**"

**CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER:** "Jesus loves everyone."

**BIBLE VERSE:** "Yes indeed, **Jesus loves everyone.** Who can help me remember what we do next? We sang our first song. What do we do now? (Pause.) Yes! We say our memory verse. Let's say our verse together! *Love each other as I have loved you*, John 15:12. Let's do it again. (Repeat several times) Yes! You've got it totally memorized now. Way to go! I am so proud of you."

**STORYTELLER:** "What is UP, everyone? You are looking so awesome today. Raise your hand if you feel awesome! (Pause) Well, I'm glad you feel awesome, because today I want to tell you something SUPER awesome and totally true. In our TRUE Bible lesson today, I'm going to show you how I know for sure that **Jesus loves everyone.**"

"This true story begins with Jesus and His friend, Peter. Peter and Jesus were really good friends. And Peter wanted everyone to know about Jesus. In fact, he said there is **NOTHING** that would ever stop him from telling people about Jesus. But Jesus told him that before the rooster crowed, Peter would say he wasn't Jesus' friend. And he would say this not one (*hold up '1' finger*), not two (*hold up '2' fingers*) but **THREE** times (*hold up '3' fingers*). Well, Peter couldn't believe this was true! There was no way he would say that Jesus wasn't his friend **THREE** times! Let's watch our video lesson and find out."
