Alley Rundown - June 2-3, 2018

Bible Story: Thou Raise Me Up (Jesus is the Cornerstone) * Ephesians 2:20-21a

Bottom Line: Jesus matters most.

Key Question: Why does Jesus matter?

Memory Verse: "I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the

"What's up Alley? Good to see you all. I'm so pumped to be starting a new month. Not just a new month, but a whole SUMMER!"

"You know Alley, I love watching all those DIY shows where people build an entire house in an afternoon. Now, do you know what the MOST important part of building a house is? It's not the type of wood you use, though that is important. It's not the color you paint it, though that's also an important decision. It is not even where your bedroom is located. The most important part of building a house is...(allow responses)."

"The foundation! Yes. Now, the foundation may not be that exciting...I mean, most of it is underground, and you never really see it. BUT if you get the foundation wrong, you can end up with a house that looks like this!"

CG: Picture of leaning house

"Woah! That would make rolling out of bed easier in the morning, though! You know Alley, having the right foundation in our lives is just as important. That's what our talk is all about today. Let's take a look..."

"There is nothing wrong with having hobbies and things that you enjoy doing like sports or music, but those things do not make a very good foundation to build our life on. Neither does... SIN. And when we try...it will only leave us disappointed. When we (you and you and you) build our lives on God's foundation, with Jesus as the cornerstone holding it all together, then we are a part of something that can never be destroyed! Let's think about this..."

"Why does Jesus matter? (Allow responses) That's a big question, but it's one each of us needs to answer if we want to live a fully alive life! Really think about it, talk it out with your small group, and figure out how you'd answer that question. Before you head to group, let's take up our offering and spend some time in worship..."
