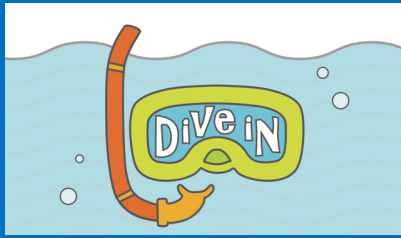

LG OVERVIEW

Noah Part 1

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: “Hello, everyone! I am so excited to be here with you today to worship God together! I can’t wait for us to hear a really awesome story about a man named Noah. This whole week we are going to learn **we can trust God**. I am going to ask you a question, and I want you to give me an answer. I am going to ask, ‘**Who can you trust?**’ Then I want you to say, ‘**I can trust God!**’ Can you try that with me? **Who can you trust?**”

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: “**I can trust God!**” (*Repeat several times.*)

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: “Great job, everyone! Now we are going to sing some really great songs. Let’s all stand up and sing!

Lead children in singing “God is Big and He Loves Me” and “I can Count on God”

BIBLE VERSE: “God loves it when we sing to Him! You did such a great job singing! We have a new Bible verse for this week. It tells us that we can trust God. It says, ‘Trust the Lord with all your heart’, Proverbs 3:5. Let’s all say it together!” (*Repeat several times.*)”

STORYTELLER: “Hello, everyone! It’s great to see you guys today. I have an AWESOME true story to share from the Bible. And I’m just going to go right ahead and tell you that today’s story is about a super BIG construction project. Today our TRUE story from the Bible begins with a man named Noah. Noah loved and trusted God, even when everyone around him didn’t. One day, God told Noah to do something very hard. God told Noah to go and build a HUGE boat called an ark. Can you say “ark”?

CHILDREN and STORYTELLER: “Ark!”

STORYTELLER: Right! But God didn’t just want Noah to build a boat. God also told Noah to obey another really important way. Let’s watch our video lesson to find out more about Noah and how he listened and trusted God.”

STORYTELLER: “Wow! Noah trusted God and obeyed when God asked him to build an ark and filled it with two of every animal. When the rain came down on those 40 days and 40 nights, the animals and Noah and his family were safe and protected inside the ark. Noah trusted God. He believed what God said and God kept him safe. Remember, friends, that God loves you. And if He tells you to do something, you can trust Him. **Who can you trust? I can trust God!**”

PRAYER: “God, we love You. Thank You for this amazing true story about how Noah chose to trust You. Because he believed You, he and his whole family and all those animals were saved. Help us to trust You, too. In Jesus’ name we pray, amen.”

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: “Now let’s stand and sing two more songs.”

Lead children in singing “Wherever I Go” and “God Does Great Things”
