

LG OVERVIEW Naaman

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "Hello, everyone! I am so excited to be here with you today to worship God together for one last night of VBS! This whole week we have been learning that we can trust God all the time. 'Who can you trust?'

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "I can trust God!" (Repeat several times.)

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "Great job, everyone! God loves when we sing to him. Let's all stand up and sing some songs to Him!

Lead children in singing "Wherever I Go" and "God Does Great Things"

BIBLE VERSE: "You did such a great job singing! Let's practice our bible verse together one last time. 'Trust the Lord with all your heart', Proverbs 3:5." (*Repeat several times*.) "You are all AMAZING at that verse! We can always trust God with all our hearts.

STORYTELLER: "Hi friends! We have one last amazing and true Bible story for you this week. Our story today begins with a man named Naaman. Naaman was the commander of the army. He had won lots of battles for the king and everyone really liked him, but sadly he had boo-boos all over his body. The boo-boos were very painful and there was no medicine to make them better. But Naaman heard about a man who loved God that could help him. Let's watch our video and see what happened next.

Watch Video Lesson

STORYTELLER: "What a great story! At first Naaman didn't think it was fair that Elisha's messenger told him to take seven baths. Seven baths! That's a lot of baths! Naaman trusted God even though it was hard and God made him better! How awesome is that? We can trust God too even when it is hard. **Who can you trust? I can trust God!**"

PRAYER: "God, we know that You are an awesome, BIG God. We know that You love us so much. Help us to trust You, like Naaman did, even when it's hard. We can always count on You. We love You. Amen.

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "Now let's stand and sing two more songs."

Lead children in singing "God is Big and He Loves Me" and "I Can Count On God"

WORSHIP LEADER/HOST: "I love singing about God! Thank you for worshipping with me today! One more time - **Who can you trust? I can trust God!**"
