HEALING THE DEAF MAN

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yay! I'm so glad to see you today! It's so much fun to sing with you. We've been learning about someone who is with us ALL THE TIME. Who is it? (*Pause.*) Yes! Jesus is always with us. **Who is there when you need Him?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Great job! We are learning about how God was there to do some AMAZING things when some people needed him. Let's sing about our Great Big God!"

(Lead children in singing "Great Big God" and "Amazing Things".)

"Great singing, my friends. Remember, **Jesus is there when I need Him. Who is there when you need Him?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

BIBLE VERSE: "It's time to practice our memory verse. Are you ready? You are everything I need, Psalm 119:57. Do it with me. (Repeat several times.)

"You are all AMAZING at that verse! Have you shown your parents yet? How about your brother and sister? How about all your good friends? Make sure you show them today!"

HOST: "Today we are going to hear a TRUE story from the Bible about a deaf man that was healed by Jesus! The deaf man couldn't hear. His ears didn't work. He needed help. Jesus had the power to help him! How do you think Jesus helped the deaf man? (*Pause.*) Let's watch our video lesson and find out. I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a single minute of our Bible lesson!"

Watch Video Lesson

HOST: "If Jesus has the power to make a deaf man hear again, He has the power to be there when we need Him? Friends, Jesus will be there whenever you need Him. Tell me: **Who is there when you need Him? Jesus is there when I need Him.**

WORSHIP LEADER: "Are you ready to sing another song with me? This one is about our Super Wonderful God!

(Lead children in singing "Super Wonderful.")

"Awesome singing, friends. Now, remind me: Who is there when you need Him?"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

WORSHIP LEADER: "That's right! And don't you forget it! See you next week!"
