

## **LG OVERVIEW**

## THE LEPERS

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Hello, hello, friends. I can't wait to sing with you. But, first, tell me: **Who is there when you need Him?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Yes!! **Jesus is there when I need Him.** I am so glad we can count on God. Let's sing about that!"

(Lead children in singing "I can Count on God" and "My God is Number One")

**WORSHIP LEADER:** "Wonderful singing, my friends. Tell me: **Who is there when you need Him?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

**BIBLE VERSE:** "Yes indeed, **Jesus is there when I need Him.** Who can help me remember what we do next? We sang our first song. What do we do now? (*Pause.*) Yes! We say our memory verse. Are you ready to say it with me? *You are everything I need*, Psalm 119:57. Let's do that together." (*Repeat several times.*)

BIBLE VERSE: "Yes! You've got it totally memorized now! Way to go!"

**HOST:** "Today we are going to hear a TRUE story from the Bible about ten men that were healed by Jesus! Yes! **10** men!! (*Hold up 10 fingers*) The sick men couldn't live with their families because they didn't want to get anyone else sick. They needed help. Jesus had the power to help them! How do you think Jesus helped the sick men? (*Pause.*) Let's watch our video lesson and find out. I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a single minute of our Bible lesson!"

**HOST:** "If Jesus has the power to make the sick men all better, He has the power to be there when we need Him! Friends, Jesus will be there whenever you need Him. Tell me: **Who is there when you need Him? Jesus is there when I need Him.** 

**WORSHIP LEADER:** Let's sing one more song about the amazing things that Jesus can do!

(Lead children in singing "Amazing Things")

"So great! Remind me one more time: Who is there when you need Him?"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "Jesus is there when I need Him."

WORSHIP LEADER: "That's right! And don't you forget it! See you next week!"
