ACTIVITY 1 ALL AGES

DANIEL AND THE LIONS

Zoo/Farm Animals

Big Idea:

<u>4's/5's</u>: Children will identify and separate animals into two baskets based on whether they are typically found at the zoo or on a farm.

2's/3's: Children will scatter and collect the animals.

What You Need: Around 20 stuffed animals (try to include one lion in each classroom), and two baskets.

What You Do:

2/3 Year olds:

- Scatter the animals around the room.
- Ask the children to collect them and bring them to the basket.
- Practice making the sounds of the animals as they bring them to you.

4/5 Year olds:

- Show the children the different animals and ask whether each animal would be found in a zoo or on a farm.
- Scatter the animals around the room.
- Show them that one basket is for zoo animals, and one is for farm animals.
- Have the kids find the animals and put them in the correct basket.
- Continue playing, timing the kids to see how long they take to put all of the animals in the correct basket.
- Play as time allows and then *Bring it Back to Jesus

Lion's Paw Memory Verse

Big Idea:

Children will run around the paw print "bases" while practicing their memory verse.

What You Need: Paw "bases" (4 paws on paper plates)

What You Do:

- Arrange the paw paper plates in a diamond shape in the center of the room.
- Have the children run from paw to paw while saying part of their memory verse as they stand NEXT TO the plate.
- Make sure the kids stand NEXT TO the paw plate and not on it so they don't slide. (You
 may use white carpet tape underneath to secure.)

1st paw: "He is the great God"

2ndpaw "the mighty"

3rd paw: "and awesome God." 4th paw: "Deuteronomy 10:17"

Big Idea:

Children will play with the parachute and stuffed toy lions.

What You Need: Parachute and stuffed toy lions

What You Do:

- Invite the children to stand around the parachute.
- Encourage the children to each take hold of the parachute and lift it off the ground.
- Place the lions onto the parachute.
- Instruct the children to move their arms up and down to move the parachute and send the lions up in the air and right out of the lions' den.
- Repeat several times and then *Bring it Back to Jesus

What You Need: "God Protects Me Shield" Activity Page on white cardstock, something to color the shield (can be dot markers, crayons, markers, watercolors, etc.) and stickers

STORY/PRAYER TIME

What you Need: Parent Take Home Card, Storybook "Polar Bear, Polar Bear What Do You Hear," Playdoh, Cookie Cutters, Rolling Pins, and Sticker Roll

Read: Have the children sit at the table while you read the book, "Polar Bear, Polar Bear What Do You Hear." The Children can either play with **playdoh** or color the **coloring sheet** to keep their hands busy while you read.

Review: Ask the kids some questions and give them a sticker when they answer.

- Go from child to child and have them repeat the memory verse for a sticker.
- Ask the children the Bottom Line question for a sticker.
- Using the Parent Take Home card, ask each child individually the questions pertaining to this week's lesson and give out a sticker.

Pray: Ask the kids to bow their heads and fold their hands while you pray. Here is a sample prayer you can use if you choose:

"Dear God, we know that you are great and mighty and can do anything. Thank you that you are always with us and will teach us the way to go. We love you, Amen."
