Memory Verse Circles

Big Idea: Children will hop from hoop to hoop while practicing their memory verse.

What You Need: Four Hula-Hoops

What You Do:

Lay the Hula-Hoops on the floor in a path, leaving some space between each hoop.

• Show the children how to hop from one hoop to the next, as they say the memory verse.

Hoop 1: He is the great God

Hoop 2: the mighty

Hoop 3: and awesome God. Hoop 4: Deuteronomy 10:17

Big Idea:

What You Need: A inflatable torch

What You Do:

- Hold up your torch.

- Encourage the children to play "Follow the Leader" as they follow you around the room.
- Change up the way you travel as they follow you: skip, hop, jump, march, etc.

Pass the Torch Bottom Line

Big Idea:

Children will practice their bottom line while playing a game similar to "Hot Potato" but with a torch instead of a potato.

What You Need: Inflatable torch

What You Do:

- Have the children sit in a circle close to one another.
- Say the bottom line with the children, "God's got it!"
- Pass the crown around the circle, randomly saying, "STOP," each round.
- When you say, "STOP," the child holding the crown will hold up the torch while you all repeat this month's bottom line together.
- When you finish saying the bottom line, the child may start passing the torch around the circle again.
- Continue passing, calling "STOP," and repeating this month's memory verse as time and interest allow then *Bring it Back to Jesus.

STORY/PRAYER TIME

What you Need: Parent Take Home Card, Storybook "I Can Do Anything", Playdoh, Cookie Cutters, Rolling Pins, and Sticker Roll
