LARGE GROUP Wonderfully Made

HOST:

"Hello, friends! I am so excited to see you today. We are going to have an awesome time this month talking about the most wonderful thing that God made. Do you know what it is? (Pause.) Yes! You! God made me, and God made you. When I ask you this very important question, 'Who made you?' you say, 'God made me.' Let's try it. Who made you?" ('God made me!')

"Yes, he did! Today I want to start off our worship time by singing Great Big God. Listen closely for when we sing the words "Cuz he's known me and he's loved me since before the world began." Isn't that amazing? God knew he was going to make you before he even created the world! Let's sing!"

SONG 1: GREAT BIG GOD

SONG 2: EVERYBODY SING

WORSHIP LEADER:

"God made everything – even you! Let me ask you that important question again – Who made you? ('God made me!')

"That's right! **God made me.** Today we have a brand new bible verse that tells us exactly that. Right here in the Bible it says: I am (point thumbs to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made (clap hands together), Psalm 139:14. (Hold hands open like a book.) Let's try that together." (*Practice a couple more times.*)

Great job! Each and every one of you was wonderfully made by God!"

STORYTELLER:

"Boys and Girls, today I have something to share with you straight from the Bible, and it is really big! Tell me, when we read something in the Bible, is it true? [Pause] Yes! You are right! Everything in the Bible is TRUE! We can know that for sure. Today, I want to go WAY back to the beginning. Did you know that before God created the world, He knew He was going to make you? He loved you all the way back then. (Hold up a Bible.)

The bible says that God made each and every one of us in our own special and wonderful way. Let's see what Ollie has to say about this!

OLLIE VIDEO: WONDERFULLY MADE

STORYTELLER:

"We're all different. God made each and every one of us wonderful in our own special way. There is no one exactly like you. ALL of us are wonderfully made. Repeat that after me: I am wonderfully made. ("I am wonderfully made.")

Turn to the person next to you and say: 'You are wonderfully made!' ("You are wonderfully made!")

And we can know that for sure because God made you and God made me! Who made you?" ("God made me.")

"Let's pray together and thank God for creating each one of us."

PRAYER "Dear God, You are a great big, AWESOME God! Not only did You make each one of us but You also made each of us WONDERFULLY! And you did that because You love us. And we love You, God. Thank you! Amen!"

HOST:

I am so excited because I have a brand-new song to teach you today and it is all about how God made us and how he loves us more than anything! Let's stand up and try it!
