Bible Story: Back 2 Good (Every Good and Perfect Gift) • *James 1:17a*

Bottom Line: Show God's goodness to others.

Key Question: How can you show God's goodness to others?

Memory Verse: “being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.” *Philippians 1:6, NIV*

1. Just for Fun

What You Need: “Goodness Word Search” Page (1 per student), pens

What You Do:

- **Give** kids a “Goodness Word Search” and a pen.
- **Challenge** kids to find the “goodness” in the word search—who could find the most “goodness?” (*Note: Goodness shows up 14 times.*)

2. Get Your Head in the Game

What You Need: 8 gift bags (G-O-O-D-N-E-S-S), white floor tape

What You Do:

- **Divide** the kids into teams.
 - Ideally you want at least five kids on a team, and teams need to have the same number of kids.
 - If necessary, combine Small Groups for this activity.
- **Instruct** teams to line up, one student behind the other.
- Behind each team, **create** a line using floor tape.
- **Place** a set of eight gift bags in front of each team and point out the letters on the bags.
- Teams will race, transporting the bags through their lines and placing the bags in order on the floor tape, to spell the word for the day (goodness).
- **Explain** the rules:
 - The first kid passes the bag over his head to the teammate behind him.
 - The next kid passes the bag between her legs to her teammate.
 - Once the bag reaches the end of the line, the kid at the end of the line places the bag on the floor tape.
 - When the bags are in the correct order, the team sits down and shouts the word of the day. The first team to do this wins.
- If time allows, **play again**, varying how the bags are passed. For example, kids pass the bags with their eyes closed or using only their feet, etc.

What You Say:

“The word for today is GOODNESS! Anyone want to guess why we used gift bags in this activity? (*Allow kids to shout out answers. If necessary, propose a reason. For example, maybe because they had handles and they were easy to pass or because gifts are good—who wouldn’t want a gift.*)

3. Memory Verse Scramble

What You Need: Bibles, Memory Verse Cards (2 sets per group)

What You Do:

- Look up Philippians 1:6, and review it together as a group.
- Divide your group into 2 teams.
- Give each team a set of “Memory Verse Cards”.
- Scatter the cards on the floor/table face down.
- On your “GO!” teams will compete to put the verse in order.
- Play as many rounds as time/interest allows.
