Bible Story: Kind & Generous (Good Samaritan) • Luke 10:25-37

Bottom Line: Be kind to everyone.

Key Question: How can you be kind even when it's hard?

Memory Verse: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness,

faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Galatians 5:22-23a, NIV

1. Take a Snapshot

What You Need: "Random Acts of Kindness Bingo" Sheet, markers/pens

What You Do:

- **Invite** students to fill in the sections of the "Random Acts of Kindness Bingo" activity page by creating a list of acts of kindness that they can do for someone else.
- **Suggest** that they think about other people they know who are kind then combine those qualities with the things they know about God's view of kindness as they think of what an act of kindness is.
 - Examples: Giving a high five, inviting a friend to play, sharing, doing someone's chores for them, giving someone food, donating clothes, etc.

What You Say:

"Can you imagine if the world was filled with people who were always looking to complete this sheet every day? What a great place it would be. We might not be able to change the entire world by being kind to others, but we will absolutely make a difference in the lives of those we know. People who follow Jesus have the Holy Spirit to help them live with kindness—even when we're around those who aren't easy to like."

2. "This is My Neighbor"

What You Need: "This is My Neighbor Interview Questions" Sheet (1 per student), Pens

What to Do:

- Have students pair up and interview each other, one at a time, using the "This is my Neighbor Interview Questions" Sheet.
- Once completed, have students introduce their new friends and share answers to their questions.

3. Memory Verse Scramble

What You Need: Memory Verse Cards from Week 1 (2 sets per group)

What You Do:

- Place the sheets face down
- Divide group into 2 teams
- Allow students to race each other to put the verse together first
- Play a few rounds as time and interest allows
