CRAFT WEEK 1 Super Kid Frame

SUPPLIES: Super Kid Frame, Crayons, Mirror Paper, Glue stick

What You DO and SAY:

⇒ Pass out Super kid frame and crayons.

 "Today we learned that God made YOU to do big things! That's what the top of this frame says right here – 'God made me to do big things.' Let's decorate this frame and then I have something special for us to put in it."

⇒ Pass out mirrors and glue sticks.

- "Look what I have here! It's a mirror. That way every time you look at it you will remember that God made you to do big things. God made you a super kid!
- Let's glue these mirrors in the center of our frames."

⇒ Complete activity and then Bring it Back to Jesus

- "These look fantastic! Nice job, friends! Where are you going to put your frame to remind you that God made you to do big things? Maybe next to your bed? Or on the mirror in your bathroom? Or maybe on your refrigerator? Put it somewhere special so that you always remember! Tell me one more time...
- o Who made you to do big things?
- God made me to do big things!"

CRAFT WEEK 2

Lion and Sheep Puppets

SUPPLIES:

Lion cut-out, Sheep cut-out, crayons, craft sticks, tape, parent

note

What You DO and SAY:

⇒ Have children join you at the table. Pass out sheep cut-out.

"Friends, today in our true Bible story we learned that David was a shepherd when he was a boy. He protected his sheep. Today we are going to make a sheep puppet. If you want to decorate yours with crayons you can. Now let's tape the stick onto the sheep so we can use it as a puppet. Great job!"

⇒ Pass out lion cut-out.

- "Do you remember what happened next in our true Bible story? David had to protect his sheep from a lion! Oh my goodness! Can you imagine how scary that must have been? But Daniel remembered that God was with him and that God made him to do BIG things!
- Let's make our lion puppets now. Can you color your lion to make it look like a real lion? Now let's attach it to the craft stick."

⇒ Use puppets to reenact the story.

- "Let's reenact our Bible story! I need everybody to hold up their sheep. Let's pretend to be David's sheep. What do sheep say? Baa! Everybody Baa with me!
- Alright now I need one friend to be the lion. Alright lion, what do lions say? RAWR! Very scary!
- Now who wants to be David? Alright David, put your hands up in front of the lion and let me ask you an important question – 'Who made you to do big things?' 'God made me to do big things!' That's right!"

⇒ Complete craft and Bring it Back to Jesus

- Boys and Girls, we may never be face to face with a lion, but sometimes we are going to be in a place where we are scared or where we have to do something hard. And we can trust God! We can remember that God made us to do big things! One more time...
- o Who made you to do big things?
- o God made me to do big things!"

(Be sure to add parent note to each child's take home bag)

ACTIVITY #1 Week 1

Big Things to Do

SUPPLIES: 1 set of Big Things cards and Big Things pictures, Blue wall tape

SET-UP: Tape the Big Things pictures around the room.

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ Gather children around a table or on the floor. Show them that you have a set of cards.
 - "Today in our true Bible story we learned that God made David to do big things, even though he was just a little boy! God made YOU to do big things, too! We are going to figure out some of the big things we can do!
 - I have a set of cards here and I am going to have one of my friends pick one card from the set."
- ⇒ Have a child pick one card from the set. If it is one of the wall pictures, have all of the children run to that spot.
 - "What do you see? Do you see a matching picture anywhere in the room? Let's run over there!
 - Child carrying groceries: Yes, this child is carrying the groceries! He is helping. Helping others is a big thing we can do.
 - Child praying: Can you pray and talk to God? Sure! That's a big thing we can do.
 - Children hugging: I like warm hugs! Showing love to others is a BIG thing. Can you give hugs and show love?
 - Child giving a fist bump: Oh look, that's a fist bump. They look like friends choosing to be kind. Is showing kindness a big thing you can do?
- ⇒. Complete the activity and Bring it Back to Jesus.
 - "That was so fun! God made each of us to do big things like helping, praying, loving others, and showing kindness.
 - o Who made you to do big things?
 - o God made me to do big things!"

ACTIVITY #1 Wk 2 Places to go

SUPPLIES: Places to Go pictures, toy cars, wall tape

SET-UP: Tape Places to Go pictures around the room

What You DO and SAY:

⇒ Give each child a car.

- "Today in our true Bible story we learned that God made us to do big things anywhere! That means no matter where we go we can do the big things God made us to do!
- Let's pretend to take a drive today. Everybody, get your cars ready.
 Let's drive!

⇒ Drive cars to each picture.

- Here we are at ______. Friends, what do you do when you are here? Did you know God made you to do Big things everywhere you go?! Who made you to do BIG things? God made me to do BIG things!
- o Let's drive to our next stop!
 - Home
 - Beach
 - Playground
 - Drive-Restaurant
 - Grandparent's House
 - Park

⇒ Complete the activity and Bring it Back to Jesus.

- "Friends, God made you to do BIG things and you can do them anywhere! God is with you every place you go and so you can be a SUPER kid! Tell me one more time...
- Who made you to do BIG things?
- o God made me to do BIG things!

ACTIVITY #2 Finding Sheep

SUPPLIES: Basket/Bucket, Extra Large Cotton Balls

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ Have children join you in the center of the room.
 - Week 1: "Friends, today in our true Bible story we learned about a big named David. God chose David to be the King when he grew up, but do you remember what he did when he was a little boy? That's right! He was a shepherd. Today we are all going to be shepherds, too!
 - Week 2: "Friends, today in our true Bible story we learned about a time when David protected his sheep from a Lion! Wow! God made him to do Big things! Well today we are all going to be shepherds, too!"
- ⇒ Have children close their eyes. Scatter the "sheep" around the room.
 - "Alright little shepherds. God made you to do big things! Open you eyes and go find your sheep!
- ⇒ When all the sheep have been found, say...
 - O Who made you to do big things? God made me to do big things!
- ⇒ Repeat as long as children are interested and then Bring it Back to Jesus.
 - "Great job, shepherds! You did a great job taking care of those sheep. Even though you are small, God made you to do BIG things, just like David! Tell me...
 - O Who made you to do big things? God made me to do big things!

SUPPLIES: None

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ This activity can be done from spots at the table or spaced out in the center of the room.

- ⇒ Do memory verse all together in a variety of ways.
 - "First, let's say it once together. 'Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid...for the Lord your God goes with you.' Deuteronomy 31:6
 - Now let's try it...
 - Super loud
 - Super quiet
 - Really fast
 - Really Slow
 - Jumping up and down
 - Running in Place
 - All the boys
 - All the girls
 - Kids only
 - Teachers only
- ⇒ Repeat as long as children are interested. If time permits, you can do one person at a time and give out stickers.

CONNECT IT AND PRAY

CONNECT IT QUESTION: God has big things for _____ to do!

- ⇒ "David had no idea what big things God had for him to do when he was a young boy taking care of sheep. But now we know that God has big things for everyone to do including you! That's why I am going to go around the table and we are going to say God has big things for _____ to do! And God has big things for ____ to do. I am going to write your name down so we remember that God has big things for every one of us to do.
 - Write the names down on the weekly question strip/board/paper.
- ⇒ You really are SUPER kids! God has big things in store for you to do. Let's pray!
- ⇒ Let's fold our hands and bow our heads and **pray**:
 - "Dear God, You are amazing! You made the whole world and everything in it, and that means You made (name each child). And not only did You make each of them, but You made them to be super kids and do big things! I pray they will always look to You to know what to do. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."

 - Who made you to do big things?God made me to do big things!
- ⇒ Memory Verse

CONNECT IT AND PRAY

CONNECT IT QUESTION: Where is one place you go?

- ⇒ "We go to a lot of places: church, school, the grocery store, the park, our grandparents' house, our bedroom. We go to cities and beaches, mountains and deserts. Sometimes we even fly in an airplane! And the good news is, God made us to do big things anywhere! And because God made us to do big things anywhere, let's make a list of places we go and use it when we pray. When I say your name, tell me one place you go, and I will write it down.
 - Have each child share and write the ideas down on the weekly question strip/board/paper.
- ⇒ These are some cool places! Let's pray and thank God for making us to do big things in all of these places.
- ⇒ Let's fold our hands and bow our heads and **pray**:
 - "Dear God, You are such a good, good God. You are so wise and powerful. There is no one more SUPER than You! Thank You for making us to do big things anywhere, like at (read the list the children made.) Help us listen to You and do what You say. You are the best, God, and we love You! In Jesus' name, amen.
