"Great job everyone! Let's get started with our story today. This story took place in the town of Capernaum. It happened during the time Jesus lived on Earth. Jesus was teaching amazing things that no one had ever heard before. Not only that, He was healing people who were sick! When Jesus came to Capernaum, He was teaching people, including Pharisees and teachers of the law. As you can imagine, EVERYONE wanted to see Jesus. They wanted to hear what He had to say . . . and find out what He would do next."

"One day, Jesus was teaching in someone's house. There were so many people who came to listen that the house was completely full! Then, some men came. They were carrying a man who couldn't walk. The friends couldn't take the man into the house because they couldn't make it through the crowd. But they REALLY wanted to get him to Jesus. So, they did something VERY interesting! Let's take a look at this week's video to find out what they did!"

"Through the power of God and the help of a few friends, this man who couldn't walk before was now on his own two feet! His life was changed FOREVER!

"Think about what these men did for their friend. They knew that he needed to get to Jesus. So, they did everything they possibly could to make it happen! They saw someone in need, and they worked together to do something to help.

"As followers of Jesus, that's what we should do, too. Let's learn this week's Bottom Line!"

Please help us work together like they did. Show us how we can share Your love by helping people in need. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

"I know it always feels good when someone helps me. Like if I need someone to talk to, it's great to have a friend who's there to listen. If I need help when I'm working on something tough, it's always better when someone helps me understand it. We should **treat others the way we want to be treated** by being willing to stop and lend a hand."
