Today's Bottom Line: Friends stand up for one another.

Have kids get into their small groups Before you start Large Groups

SLIDE: Theme

Hello, my friends! Everybody find a friend next to you and give them a high five or a fist bump. (*Pause.*) Now do that with another friend. (*Pause.*) All month long here in the CITY we're talking about friendship.

SLIDE: Virtue

Friendship is using your words and actions to show others you care.

SLIDE: Theme

It's so good to have friends! Friendship is really a gift from God. We can count on our friends to be there for us through thick and thin. And we want to be the kind of friend who THEY can count on, too. We can do that with God's help!

Let's talk in our groups about friendship. I'm going to give you some time to discuss this question as a group....

When has a friend of yours done something to help you? (walk around and listen to kids' answer is their groups. Bring them back together in a few minutes when most groups are done).

Well, today we are going to look in the Bible (hold up Bible) and find another great story of friendship.

We can find this story in the book of Acts, which tells all about what happened in the early days of the church. This was after Jesus died on the cross, came back to life, then went to heaven. God sent the Holy Spirit to the believers, and the new church began to grow quickly. Let's check out the Story Lab...

I love that story! Barnabas stood up for Saul when nobody else would. You can understand why the believers in Jerusalem found it hard to believe that Saul had changed. But Barnabas made sure they knew about everything Saul had been through, and how Saul was now sharing the good news about Jesus just like them.

Of course, God went on to use Saul and the other believers in a big way. The church continued to grow, and they helped more and more people learn about and follow Jesus!

This is a really important part of friendship. Let's watch Greg for our bottom line...

SLIDE: Bottom Line

Friends stand up for one another.

I know I would want my friends to stand up for me if I felt alone, or if I felt like other people didn't understand me. If we can stand up for each other, that's a great way that we can treat others the way we want to be treated.

Can you think of some ways you can stand up for your friends? Maybe the next time you see your friend doing something great, speak up and let them know you noticed! Or maybe you notice that your friend is feeling left out. You could speak up and tell your other friends to be sure to include them.

I bet you can think of some other great ideas of how we can stand up for our friends. We will talk about that more in a minute when we start small group time. Let's pray.

Please give us the courage to stand up for others and be the kind of friends they can count on. Thank You for giving us friends who can be there for us and stand up for us.
