## CRAFT – December 3<sup>rd</sup> Jesus is the present

**SUPPLIES:** Jesus is the present page, crayons, heart stampers

#### What You DO and SAY:

#### ⇒ Give each child a Jesus is the present page and crayons.

- "Today in our true Bible study we learned that an angel named Gabriel visited Mary to tell her that she was going to have a baby. That baby was a special gift from God – Jesus! Jesus is so special because he is God's son!
- I have a special picture for you to create today that will help you remember our true story! Your paper looks like a present. Who do you see on your paper? It's the angel and Mary! Let's color our picture.
- ⇒ While children are working, open <u>The Beginner's Bible</u> and read *An Angel Visits Mary, p. 267*
- ⇒ Have children use heart stampers to stamp hearts around Jesus.
  - "Point to the angel. What was the important message the angel told Mary? Yes! She was going to have a baby and His name would be Jesus. Jesus is God's Son.
  - Now open your paper. Who's inside? Baby Jesus! That's the best present of all! Stamp hearts all around Jesus. Great job. Now close your paper and help me review today's story.

#### ⇒ Retell the story and Bring it Back to the Bottom Line.

- Our Bible story is about the true story of Christmas, and it begins with a girl named Mary. God had an important message for her. God sent an angel to give Mary an important message! Mary was surprised and a little afraid. But the angel said, 'Do not be afraid Mary! God says you are going to have a baby and you will call Him Jesus.'
- Jesus would be SO special because . . . Jesus is God's Son! Wow!
   God loves you and me SO much that God gave us His only Son, Jesus.
- How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!"

## CRAFT – December 10<sup>th</sup> Nativity Sticker Scene

**SUPPLIES:** Nativity Sticker Scene

**TIP:** For the tiniest fingers, sometimes it helps to peel the outline of the

stickers off the backing page so that they can peel the stickers off

more easily on their own!

#### ⇒ Hold up completed sticker scene example page.

 "Today we heard the next part of our true story from the Bible about when baby Jesus was born. Today we are going to put together a beautiful sticker scene that tells each part of the story.

#### ⇒ Pass out sticker scene kits

"Let's put our sticker scenes together! Can you find the stable?"

(Draw their attention to each part of the story and assemble the sticker scene together. Continue the conversation as they are putting the craft together and engage them in talking about each element)

⇒ While children are working, open <u>The Beginner's Bible</u> and read *Baby Jesus is Born, p. 271.* 

#### ⇒ Complete craft and Bring it Back to Jesus

- "This is beautiful! Can you imagine how special it would have been to be there that night when baby Jesus was born? God gave us the most special present ever. He sent his son Jesus for me and for you!
- Why is Jesus special? Jesus is God's son!"

## CRAFT – December 17<sup>th</sup> Shepherd Run and Tell

**SUPPLIES:** 

Manger/Sheep scene with parent note on back, Shepherd puppet with finger cut-outs, crayons

#### ⇒ Hold up Manger/Sheep scene.

- "Today we heard the next part of our true story from the Bible about when baby Jesus was born. An angel came to tell the shepherds while they were out in the field watching their sheep.
- Do you see the sheep in the picture? Let's color the sheep and the field, and the stable with baby Jesus in it!"
- ⇒ While children are working, open <u>The Beginner's Bible</u> and read *Shepherds Visit, p. 277.*
- ⇒ Pass out shepherd finger puppet.
  - "After the angels left the shepherds RAN to go see baby Jesus! Look who I have here! A shepherd!
  - o Let's color our shepherd."
- ⇒ While children are working, open <u>The Beginner's Bible</u> and read *Shepherds Visit, p. 277.* 
  - "Do you see the 2 little holes in your shepherd? That is for your fingers!
     Let's put your two little fingers through the holes. Now look you can
     use your fingers to help the shepherd RUN and see baby Jesus!
  - And do you remember what they did after they ran to see baby Jesus and worship him? They RAN and told everyone else that God had sent his son Jesus!"
- ⇒ Complete craft and Bring it Back to Jesus
  - o "The shepherds knew that Jesus was special because he was God's son and they ran and told everyone! We can do the same!
  - o How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!

## CRAFT – Christmas Services Happy Birthday, Jesus hats

**SUPPLIES:** Party Hats, Stickers

NOTE: You may want to add a piece of tape to help the hats stay together!

#### What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ Give each child a party hat and stickers. Show them the example, and explain that we are making them to celebrate Jesus' birthday.
  - "We are having a birthday party today to celebrate Jesus' birthday! Today you get to make your own special party hat and decorate it!"
- ⇒ Let the children decorate their party hats with the stickers.

  Be sure to write each child's name on the inside of his/her hat.
- ⇒ Bring it Back to Jesus.
  - "Your hats look awesome! I think it's time to have a party! If you want, you can wear your hats for the rest of class as we celebrate Jesus' Birthday! God sent Jesus to us at Christmas because he loves us so much!
  - o How do we know God loves us?
  - God gave us Jesus!

Children can wear their hats for the rest of the "party" or put them in their bag.

# ACTIVITY #1 Look and Find Bows

**SUPPLIES:** Gift Bows in box

- ⇒ Gather children in the center of the room.
  - "In our Bible story today, we found out about a very special baby who was going to be born! That baby was the most special present God ever gave us!
  - Look at all these bows I have! Where do we put bows? Right! On presents! These bows will help us remember that Jesus was the best present ever."
- ⇒ Scatter the bows around the room.
  - "Let's find the bows and see if we can find them all! Bring them back to me!"
- ⇒ Have children collect all the bows.
  - o "Great work, everybody! You found all the bows.
  - o How do we know God loves us?
  - God gave us Jesus!"
- ⇒ Let the children play as long as they are interested.
- ⇒ Bring it Back to Jesus.
  - "God gave us Jesus and he was Jesus was the best present ever! Jesus is God's son!
  - o How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!

# ACTIVITY #2 Memory Verse

**SUPPLIES:** Award Stickers

- ⇒ This activity can be done from spots at the table or spaced out in the center of the room.
  - "Friends, we have an awesome memory verse to practice! I want to try saying it in lots of different ways!
- ⇒ Do memory verse all together in a variety of ways.
  - o "First, let's say it once together.
  - o 'God loved the world so much that He gave his only son.' John 3:16
    - Now let's try it...
      - Super loud
      - Super quiet
      - Really fast
      - Really Slow
      - Jumping up and down
      - Running in Place
      - All the boys
      - All the girls
      - Kids only
      - Teachers only
- ⇒ Repeat as long as children are interested. If time permits, you can do one person at a time and give out stickers.
- ⇒ Complete the activity and then Bring it Back to Jesus.
  - "Nice work, my friends! God loved us so much that he gave his only son! Jesus is so special!"
  - How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!

# ACTIVITY #3 Nativity Play

**SUPPLIES:** Nativity Play Set

- ⇒ Gather children around you on the floor or at a table. (This activity works best in a smaller group)
  - "Friends! Look at what I have here! It's a stable! And look at all these people and animals! I am going to give everybody one person or animal and we are going to tell the story together!
- ⇒ Give each child one piece (or two depending on how many kids are in group). As you talk about the story, add the characters to the nativity.
  - "Before Mary had baby Jesus, an angel told her that Jesus was going to be born. Who has the angel?
  - When it was time for the baby to be born, Mary and Joseph had to take a long trip all the way to Bethlehem! Who has Mary? What about Joseph?
  - Do you remember what they rode? A donkey! Who has a donkey?
     Everybody say hee-haw!
  - o Then, God's son was born! Baby Jesus! Who has baby Jesus?
  - When baby Jesus was born there were animals there. Who has an animal? What does your animal say?
  - There were shepherds who took care of the sheep! Does anyone have a shepherd? An angel told the shepherds about baby Jesus and they ran to see him!
  - Baby Jesus had other visitors, too! Three kings came to worship him!
     Who has the wise men?
- ⇒ Repeat activity as long as kids are interested and Bring it Back to Jesus.
  - "Boys and Girls, this is an amazing story, isn't it? God had such a perfect plan when he brought Jesus into the world. God loves us so much that he gave us Jesus. Jesus is so special. Jesus is God's son!
  - o How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!

### READ, REVIEW, REFLECT, AND PRAY December 3

**SUPPLIES:** Moon sand, book, reward stickers

#### **READ**

- ⇒ Read Christmas Angels by Crystal Bowman
  - Read the story and then say: Wow! Isn't it amazing how God used angels to announce Jesus' birth? I am so thankful God sent us Jesus! He is the best present ever!

#### **REVIEW**

- ⇒ Review the following with the kids. Go over them as a group and/or ask each child individually
  - Key Question/Bottom Line: How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!
  - Memory Verse:
     'God loved the world so much that he gave his only son.' John 3:16

#### **REFLECT**

- Reflect on the lesson and ask each child to answer the question. Write their name and answers on the board.
  - "Today we learned about how God sent an angel to tell Mary that she was going to have a baby named Jesus and that he was going to be the best present ever. God gives us so many wonderful things!
  - Let's make a list of things God has given us. God has given us food, family, friends, sunshine, animals—God has given us SO many things! So when I say your name, tell me one thing God has given you, and I will write it down."

#### **PRAY**

"Dear God, You have given us SO much! [Child's name] wants to thank You for giving us (read what's listed). (Repeat for each child). Most of all, we want to thank You for giving us Jesus. Jesus is the best gift ever! We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."

### READ, REVIEW, REFLECT, AND PRAY December 10

**SUPPLIES:** Moon sand, book, reward stickers

#### **READ**

⇒ Read Christmas in the Manger by Nola Buck

 Read the story and then say: I am so thankful God gave us Jesus. Jesus is so special because he is God's son!

#### REVIEW

- ⇒ Review the following with the kids. Go over them as a group and/or ask each child individually
  - Key Question/Bottom Line:
     How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!
  - Memory Verse:
     'God loved the world so much that he gave his only son.' John 3:16

#### **REFLECT**

- Reflect on the lesson and ask each child to answer the question. Write their name and answers on the board.
  - "Today we are going to make a list of things Jesus grew up to do. I mean, baby Jesus didn't stay a baby, did He? No! Jesus grew up to do amazing things! Jesus fed lots and lots of people, He walked on water, He calmed storms, He made sick people all better, He was a good friend to everyone, and He taught people about God. Jesus grew up and did all kinds of wonderful things! When I say your name, tell me one thing Jesus did when He grew up, and I will write it down."

#### **PRAY**

"Dear God, Thank You for giving us Jesus. Thank You that He grew up to do amazing things like (read the list the children made) AND He died and came back, just like He said He would! Jesus does things only He can do. That makes Him the most AMAZING friend EVER! We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."

### READ, REVIEW, REFLECT, AND PRAY December 17

**SUPPLIES:** Moon sand, book, reward stickers

#### **READ**

- ⇒ Read *J is for Jesus* by Crystal Bowman
  - Read the story and then say: I am so thankful God gave us Jesus. Jesus is so special because he is God's son!

#### **REVIEW**

- ⇒ Review the following with the kids. Go over them as a group and/or ask each child individually
  - Key Question/Bottom Line:
     How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!
  - Memory Verse:
     'God loved the world so much that he gave his only son.' John 3:16

#### **REFLECT**

- Reflect on the lesson and ask each child to answer the question. Write their name and answers on the board.
   [Who is one person you can tell about Jesus?]
  - "When the angels came and told the shepherds that baby Jesus was born, they went to see him right away. They were so excited that they ran and told everyone that God gave us Jesus! Today we are going to make a list of people we can tell God gave us Jesus, just like the shepherds did. When I say your name, tell me one person you can tell that God gave us Jesus, and I will write it down."

#### **PRAY**

"Dear God, we want everyone to know that God gave us Jesus. Please help [child's name] tell [person's name] God gave us Jesus. (Repeat for each child.) We love You, God! In Jesus' name, amen."

### READ, REVIEW, REFLECT, AND PRAY Christmas Eve Services

SUPPLIES: Moon sand, book, reward stickers

#### **READ**

⇒ Read Happy Birthday, Jesus! by Michelle Medlock Adams

 Read the story and then say: Friends! That is why we celebrate Christmas! It is Jesus' birthday. God sent Jesus to us because he loves us so much!

#### **REVIEW**

- ⇒ Review the following with the kids. Go over them as a group and/or ask each child individually
  - Key Question/Bottom Line: How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!
  - Memory Verse:
     'God loved the world so much that he gave his only son.' John 3:16

#### REFLECT

- Reflect on the lesson and ask each child to answer the question. Write their name and answers on the board. [Who did God send Jesus for?]
  - "Today we are celebrating Jesus' birthday party. Usually at birthday parties, there are presents. But do you know the special thing about this party? The present was for you! God sent his son Jesus as a special present for YOU. So today I am going write YOUR name on the board.

#### **PRAY**

"Dear God, thank You for sending your son Jesus for [say each child's name]. We are so glad Jesus was born and He wants to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."

#### Hey, Volunteers! MERRY CHRISTMAS!

 Thank you SO much for giving the gift of your time during this season. You are making an eternal impact with every child as you share the good news that God loves them so much, and that he sent his son Jesus to be their friend forever!

You may notice there are more activities than normal today.

There is NO pressure to do every activity! I wanted to provide you with lots of options for this fun service! You can make your own best decision based on the size of your class, the age of the kiddos, and the vibe of the classroom 

Have fun making it your own.

Remember, all that really matters is that our kids walk out knowing:

1. God loves me!

- 2. God gave us Jesus!
- 3. Jesus is special because he is God's son!

  - How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!

# ACTIVITY #5 Bows Parachute

**SUPPLIES:** Gift Bows, Parachute

- ⇒ Have children join you and stand in a circle in the center of the room.
  - o "Today we learned the answer to a very important question:
  - o Why is Jesus special?
  - Jesus is God's son"
- ⇒ Ask children to stand around the parachute with you and guide them to each pick up a section of the parachute.
  - o "Now, everybody grab a section of the parachute.
  - I have some bows here. What do we put bows on? That's right!
     Presents! Jesus was the best present God ever gave to us! The whole reason we give presents at Christmas is to remember how much God loves us. God gave us Jesus!"
- ⇒Invite children to shake their arms so that the parachute moves very fast.
  - o "Let's shake our arms and pop these bows up into the air! Go!"
- ⇒ When all the bows have popped out of the parachute...
  - o "Why is Jesus special? Jesus is God's son."
- ⇒ Repeat activity as long as kids are interested and Bring it Back to Jesus.
  - o "That was so much fun!
  - God gave us the most awesome gift ever God sent Jesus to us because He loves us.
  - o How do we know God loves us? God gave us Jesus!
