### **CRAFT WEEK 4**

Bring the Good News

**SUPPLIES:** Label sticker, Memory verse stickers, envelopes,

crayons/markers

- ⇒ Have children take a seat at the table. Pass out the envelopes and label stickers. Let children decorate their envelope.
  - o "Friends, come sit with me at the table. We're learning that Jesus loves us and gives us joy because He wants to be our friend forever. We can tell others and share the joy that Jesus wants to be everyone's friend forever!
  - "Today we're going to decorate this envelope and put something special inside that will help us share the joy. First, stick this label on the front of your envelope. (Pause.) Now you can color your envelope to decorate it!"
- ⇒ Give each child 3 stickers to put in their envelope. Review the memory verse and give each child a sticker for saying the verse with you.
  - "Inside our envelopes, we're going to put these stickers with the memory verse on them. Count out your stickers with me—1, 2, 3 stickers! Now take those stickers and put them inside your envelope. You can give these to people to let them know that Jesus wants to be their friend forever!"
  - "Let's practice the memory verse together: 'I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people,' Luke 2:10. Great job! Here's a sticker for you!" (Put a sticker on each child.)
- ⇒ Bring it Back to the Bottom Line.
  - "Jesus is in a place called heaven right now, getting it ready for all of His friends. It will be like a party that never ends! We will have joy all of the time because we will be with our friend Jesus, and Jesus gives us joy!
  - Who gives you joy? Jesus gives me joy!"

# ACTIVITY #1 What Will Heaven Be Like?

**SUPPLIES:** Bag filled with Heaven cards, CD player, Worship CD

- ⇒ Have children sit in a circle in the middle of the room.
  - "Friends, come sit in a circle with me! In our Bible story today, we learned that Jesus is in heaven getting it ready for all His friends! In heaven, there are no more boo-boos and no sickness. In heaven we will have everything that we need. We won't get hungry or tired or sad. It will be like a party that never ends!
  - "We're going to play a game to see what will be in heaven and what will not be in heaven!"
- ⇒ Pass the bag around the room while the music plays. When the music stops, have child pull out one heaven card.
  - "Let's take turns picking a card from the bag. When the music stops, if you are holding the bag, reach in the bag, pull out a card, and show it to everyone.
  - Let's play!
  - Will [image] be in heaven? (Pause). That's right! [image] will/will not be in heaven!"
- ⇒ Let the children play until every child has had a turn.
- ⇒Bring it Back to the Bottom Line.
  - "Jesus is getting heaven ready for all of His friends, right now! Jesus wants to be our friend forever, and when Jesus is our friend forever, we can have joy with Him forever in heaven!
  - o Who gives you joy?
  - Jesus gives me joy!"

# ACTIVITY #2 Hula Hoop Bottom Ling

**SUPPLIES:** 4 Hula Hoops

- ⇒ Lay the 4 Hula hoops out in a row so that kids can easily jump from one to the next. Have kids join you near the hula hoops.
  - o "Friends, we are going to use these hula hoops to answer our big question for this month. Do you remember what it was?
  - Who gives you joy?
  - Jesus gives me joy!
  - Nice job!
- ⇒ Demonstrate hopping from hula hoop to hula hoop.
  - o "Here is what you are going to do. I will ask you 'Who gives you joy?' and then you are going to hop and answer...
  - o (Hop) Jesus (Hop) gives (Hop) me (Hop) joy!
- ⇒ Let each child take a turn hopping from hoop to hoop and answering the question.
- ⇒ Bring it Back to the Bottom Line.
  - "Nice job, friends! All month long we are learning about joy that lasts forever, no matter what. And that joy only comes from one place: Jesus! Now tell me:
  - o Who gives you joy?
  - Jesus gives me joy!"

### **ACTIVITY #3**

Share the Verse

**SUPPLIES:** Little People figures

- ⇒ Have children join you in the center of the room and spread Little People figures around the group.
  - "Friends, let's review our Memory Verse and motions together. Ready? 'I bring you (move upward-facing palms to one side) good news (move flat hand from chin to palm) of great joy (brush flat hands upward twice) that will be for all the people,' (arms out wide) Luke 2:10. (Open hands like a book.) Great job, friends."
  - "We want to share this news with all the people, so we're going to play a game to practice! Look around us, do you see all the little friends on the floor? (Pause.) When I say 'JOY,' I want you to get up, grab one of the little friends, and sit down with it. Then, we'll tell our memory verse to our friend!"
- ⇒ Have children find a Little People figure and sit down with it. Say the memory verse to the figures.
  - "'JOY!' Go find a friend and sit down! (Pause.) Set your friend down in front of you. Now, let's share our verse with the people.
  - "'I bring you good news of great that will be for all the people,' Luke 2:10. Fantastic!"
- ⇒ Repeat as long as children are interested.
- ⇒ Complete the activity and then bring it back to the bottom line.
  - "God loves us so much that God gave His Son, Jesus, to be our friend forever. Jesus came to give the whole world joy.
  - Who gives you joy?
  - Jesus gives me joy!

#### **READ**

#### **REVIEW** (You may choose to pass out stickers as kids answer!)

- ⇒Key Question and Bottom Line
  - o Who gives you Joy?
  - Jesus gives me joy!
- ⇒ Memory Verse
  - "I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people." Luke 2:10

#### CONNECT IT AND PRAY

- ⇒ "Today we Today, we're going to make a list of times we've been sick or had a boo-boo. Maybe you hurt your knee, or bumped your head, or your tummy was really sick. When I say your name, **tell** me one time you had a boo-boo, and I will write it down.
  - Have each child share and write the ideas down on the weekly guestion strip/board/paper.
- ⇒ It looks like we've all had a boo-boo or been sick at one time. Let's use our list when we pray...
- ⇒ Let's fold our hands and bow our heads and <u>pray</u>:
  - "Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to be our friend forever. Thank You that Jesus is getting heaven ready for all of His friends, where there will be no more (read the list the children made). We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."
