
# CRAFT WEEK 3 Met Full of Fish

SUPPLIES:

Fishing handout, honeycomb paper, crayons, fish stickers, glue sticks

#### What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ Give each child a fishing handout. Invite the children to color the page.
  - "Friends! Come over and join me at the table! Let's make a story craft to help us remember today's story. Look, it's Jesus with Peter and Andrew in their boat. Use the crayons to color your paper."
- ⇒ Give each child a piece of honeycomb paper and glue sticks and encourage them to gently pull the paper apart to make a net. Have the children glue to net on the page.
  - "Great! In our story, Jesus told Peter to put his fishing nets down into the water. But your picture doesn't have a net. Watch this! (Hold up one piece of honeycomb paper and gently pull it apart.) When I gently pulled the paper, it made it look like a net. Take your special piece of paper and gently pull it apart to make your net. (Pause.) Glue the net to your paper next to the boat."
- ⇒ Set out fish stickers and encourage the children to fill the nets with the fish stickers.
  - "There aren't any fish in your net. After Jesus told Peter to put his nets down into the water, Jesus did something only He has the power to do. Jesus filled the nets with fish! Add the fish stickers to your net. (Pause.) Fill your net! (Pause.) Great job, everyone!"
- ⇒ Bring it Back to the Bible Story and Bottom Line
  - "Peter and Andrew were AMAZED because they didn't think they would catch any fish, but Jesus can do anything! Jesus filled their nets with fish! Jesus can do anything.
  - "Who can do anything?
  - "Jesus can do anything!"

# ACTIVITY #1 Find the Fish

**SUPPLIES:** 3 opaque plastic cups, plush fish

#### What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ Have children gather around a table. If you have a large group, split into smaller groups with a leader for each group.
  - "Friends! Come sit over here with me. We're going to play a game to remind us of our story. In our story, what were Peter and Andrew looking for? (Pause.) That's right! Fish. But they weren't finding any fish all day. Then when Jesus came, Jesus did something amazing! He made so many fish come that the nets were breaking."
- ⇒ Set the cups face down on the table and put the fish in one of the cups. Mix the cups up and invite the children to guess where the fish is. Repeat as long as interest allows.
  - "In our game today, we're going to try to find a fish. I have 3 cups here and I'm going to put the fish in one of them. Then, I want you to watch the cup with the fish in it and I'm going to mix up the cups and see if you can keep track of the fish. (Demonstrate.) Can you remember where the fish is? (Pause.) Let's check. (Lift cup.) You found it! Let's try again! (Repeat as long as interest allows.)"
- ⇒ Bring it back to the Bible Story and Bottom Line.
  - "Peter and Andrew weren't finding any fish on their own, but when Jesus told Peter and Andrew to put their nets into the water, Jesus filled them with fish. Only Jesus has the power to do that because Jesus can do anything!
  - o Who can do anything?
  - Jesus can do anything!"

### **ACTIVITY #2**

I Can...

**SUPPLIES:** Foam cube with I Can cards in sleeves

#### What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ Invite children to spread out to get ready to play the game.
  - "Friends, come gather here with me. Everyone, put your arms out to your sides like this (spread arms out wide) so you have plenty of room. Good job! You can put your arms down."
- ⇒ Invite children to roll the cube and do the action on the card. After they've done the action, ask them the big question.
  - On this cube, there are some movements you can do! Watch this. (Roll the cube.) Oh look, it landed on 'run!' I can run. Can you run? Show me how you can run in place. (Pause.) Great job! Now tell me: Who can do anything? Jesus can do anything! Let's let someone else roll it this time. (Repeat as desired, reviewing the bottom line after each action.) You can run, and jump, and twirl, and march, and clap, and sing!"
- ⇒ Bring it back to the Bottom Line
  - "You can run, and jump, and twirl, and march, and clap, and sing, but in our true Bible Story today we heard about something that only Jesus can do because **Jesus can do anything!**
  - Who can do anything?
  - Jesus can do anything!"
