Key Question/Bottom Line:

Monthly Bible Verse:

Bible Story Intro:

Friends, we know that God has plans for us. Plans for us to learn about God, to make friends, to help people, and to share God's love with people. God has plans for things you can do now as a kid, and plans as you get older. Today we're going to hear a true Bible Story about a kid who had a BIG job and God had a BIG plan for his life. Pay attention because I'm going to ask you questions after to see what you remember! Let's watch to find out more.

Ollie Video: King Josiah

Bible Story Recap

Let's see how much you remember of our story. What was Josiah's job? (Pause.) He was king! And as king, he decided to fix the temple. What did they find while they were working? (Pause.) That's right! A book. The book had God's words in it and when King Josiah read God's words, did he keep it to himself? (Pause.) No! He wanted everyone to hear what God said. And when they heard God's words, they all decided to follow God's plans. And we can follow God's plans too, because God has plans for us!

Friends, let me ask you that important question one more time – Who has plans for you? God has plans for me! Let's say it again! Who has plans for you? God has plans for me!

Sample Prayer:
